Lisbon telegraphs the following number 25 November from Dejeto to Marshal Badoglio. FATIMA FROM MURPHY SIGNED EISENHOWER CITE PHCIV. My information concerning the attitude of the Royal Legation in Budapest is summarized as follows. The first secretary of the Legation there Baron Caro de Ferraris gave me this information confidentially on October 17. With Minister Anfuso as the head, the following have rallied to the Republican Government. Consul General Censi, Air Attache Nannini, Assistant Air Attache Romanini and 3rd Secretary Pini. The following have formally declared their loyalty to the Royal Government; Ferraris, the legation secretaries Perronecapano and Ciracolo, the Military Attache General Voli, the Commercial Attache Cacciulupi, the Assistant Commercial Attache Macchia, all the clerks in the chancery, the press Attache Stendardo and the Chief Chancery interpreter Passalacqua. On September 26 Anfuso threatened violence and with the support of the dissidents a group of Fascisti and 2 German Officers forced all personnel loyal to the Royal Government to leave the premises of the Legation. Afterwards Ferraris established the Royal Legation at Leszayautica 13 and he has been recognized as the sole legitimate representative of the Loyal Government by the Hungarian Government. Subsequently Anfuso went to Berlin and Grazzi came to assume charge of the Republican Legation although he stayed 24 hours only. Now

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Casertano is awaited. For your information I can report that I have available regular and safe means of communication to Budapest with the Royal Charge d'Affairs there.

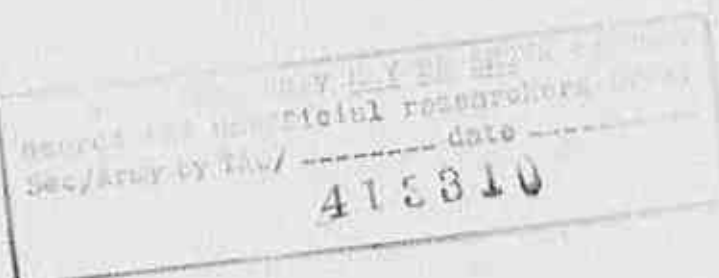

Tonnage for medical and sanitary supply items estimated and units should be shipped as nearly as possible in accordance with phased requisitions. Reggio 95 daily 950 ten days of which 800 flour 20 milk 120 dried vegetables 10 medical and sanitary. Protons 160 daily 1600 ten days of which 1200 flour 80 milk 310 dried vegetables 10 medical and sanitary. Brindisi 165 daily 1650 ten days of which 1500 flour ten milk 100 dried vegetables 20 dehydrated soup 20 medical and sanitary. Bari all repeat all tonnages exactly the same as for Brindisi. Civita Vecchia 345 daily 3450 ten days of which 2470 flour 150 milk 65 cheese 340 dried vegetables 340 dehydrated soup 60 soap 25 medical and sanitary. Naples 1000 daily 10,000 ten days of which 8000 flour 175 milk 400 cheese 600 dried vegetables 600 dehydrated soup 150 soap 75 medical and sanitary. Supplies for Naples in excess of Region III requisitions should be charged against Region 4. Region 2 and Apulia requisitions should reach you within a few days 50% wheat in lieu flour can be accepted any port except Civita Vecchia. If available caustic soda building materials and clothing as phased in requisitions all regions should be substituted for flour and dried vegetables

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but not to exceed 20% of flour in any event. Please advise action taken and your ability to accomplish shipments requested.

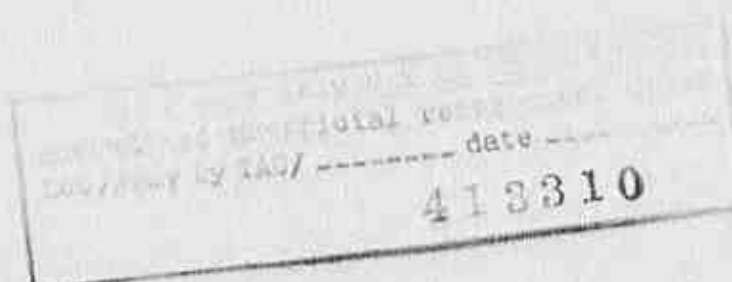

"The Conference also agreed to establish an Advisory Council for matters relating to Italy to be composed in the first instance of representatives of their three Governments and of the French Committee of National Liberation. Provision is made for addition to this council of representatives of Greece and Yugoslavia in view of their special interests arising out of aggressions of Fascist Italy upon their territory during the present war. This Council will deal with day to day questions other than military preparations and will make recommendations designed to coordinate Allied policy with regard to Italy.

The three Foreign Secretaries considered it appropriate to reaffirm by a declaration published today, the attitude of the Allied Governments in favor of the restoration of Democracy in Italy. Number 2. Text of Declaration regarding Italy. The Foreign Secretaries of the United States, United Kingdom and the Soviet Union have established that the three Governments are in complete agreement that Allied policy towards Italy must be based upon the fundamental principle that Fascism and all its evil influence and configuration shall be completely destroyed and that the Italian people shall be given every opportunity to establish governmental

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and other institutions based upon democratic principles.

The Foreign Secretaries of the United States and the United Kingdom declare that the action of their Governments from the inception of the invasion of Italian territory, in so far as paramount military requirements have permitted, has been based upon this policy.

In furtherance of this policy in the future, the Foreign Secretaries of the three Governments are agreed that the following measures are important and should be put into effect: 1. It is essential that the Italian Government should be made more democratic by inclusion of representatives of those sections of the Italian people who have always opposed Fascism. 2. Freedom of speech, of religious worship, of political belief, of press and of public meeting shall be restored in full measure to the Italian people who shall also be entitled to form anti-Fascist political groups. 3. All institutions and organizations created by the Fascist regime shall be suppressed. 4. All Fascist or pro-Fascist elements shall be removed from the administration and from institutions and organizations of a public character. 5. All political prisoners of the Fascist regime shall be released and accorded full amnesty. 6. Democratic organs of local Government shall be created. 7. Fascist chiefs and Army Generals known or suspected to be war criminals shall be arrested and handed over to justice.

In making this declaration the three Foreign Secretaries recognize that so long as active military operations continue in Italy the time at which it is possible to give full effect to the principles stated above will be determined by the Commander-in-Chief on the basis of instructions received through the Combined Chiefs of Staff. 337

The three Governments, parties to this declaration, will, at the request of any one of them, consult on this matter. It is further understood that nothing in this resolution is to operate against the right of the Italian people ultimately to

State Department telegraphs following press comment. FATIMA SIGNED EISENHOWER
SIN FROIV. Volume of editorial comment on Italy has decreased slightly. Comment directed against King grows. Badoglio position slightly improves. Reaction to Badoglio's interview was in the end largely favorable. Dorothy Thompson 28 says "Inasmuch as Badoglio is willing to accept the principles and give obedience to popular will, Badoglio is acceptable." Reservations were often appended to warm approval as in Philadelphia Inquirer October 26 "The measure of his service to Italy must be not his promises and assurances but his actual deliveries." Lynchburg News praises interview but criticizes Badoglio's silence in Fascist years. However Books Carter broadcasting October 25 in discussing interview called Badoglio an "Overnight Democrat" and after attacking him for the material gains he received from the Fascist Regime "Europe you know is full of Badoglio's and Petains." PM after contrasting interview with statement to Matthews that during conquest of Ethiopia "These were better times for Italy" says "If Badoglio can help the United Nations in Italy let him do it. But silently without speeches. Badoglio is repulsive enough as a Fascist. As a Democrat he is unbearable." These two were the only unfavorable comments noted. Gunther broadcasting October 30 interprets recent Naples Conference "Because either Badoglio himself has come to realize that he can no longer dominate the Italian Po-

litical scene or pressure from the Allies has forced him to this step." Reports are widely printed that the Communist Party is more moderate than the Action Party. Hughes Broadcasting October 31 said that Sforza "Implied that he would not join any Regime unless the abdication of Victor Emmanuel was assured. Count Sforza has taken a stand which will win support of many Italians and undoubtedly of many other peoples of the world." New York Post continues to call Sforza almost the Italian De Gaulle. Daily Worker October 25 congratulates Sforza on his opposition to Badoglio. Nation October 30 expects strong pressure on Sforza to join Badoglio Government "If he resists such pressure and we expect him to unless he is given full power to choose his associates in the Government he is likely to be drawn toward the Action Party." Nation October 30 also says "Just once has the Soviet Union deviated from its support of the Democratic Forces: when it joined with Britain and America in accepting as a co-belligerent the present Italian Regime. However it seems safe to say that while Stalin formally acquiesces in the status "is helping prepare the way for its ultimate collapse." Considerable unfavorable comment has been made especially on the radio on report regarding arrest and release of editors of underground paper. Daily Worker 23 regarding Garosci (?) Cianca Turchiani describing them as reactionaries asks "Why did the State Department send these four to Italy." New York Herald Tribune November 1 attacks censorship also mentions Badoglio favorably "Liberated Italy is enshrouded in a pall of silence perhaps of censorship which makes it difficult to give the Allied cause of freedom and Democracy that commanding appeal that glowing emotion which many believe that it should arouse. The Germans wage their political like their military warfare with infinitely more of speed and decision. The Allies naturally cannot emulate such totalitarian directness. But it does seem that they might make better use of freedom's own weapons of open debate, publicity full information and the encouragement of popular political activity than they have succeeded in doing." 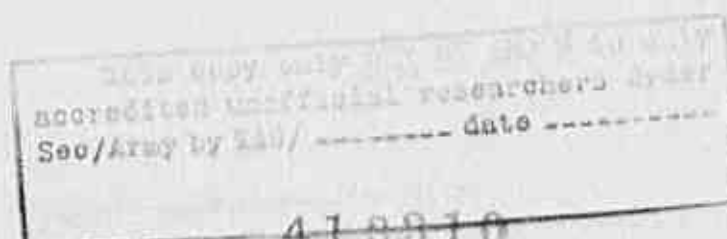

Following is text of announcement to be released at 2200A hours 10 November:

(TO: ITALIA FOR JOYCE FOR NAUFRANKE REPEATED TO: ITALY FOR WACHENBY SIGNED: EISENBERG)
CITE: ITOMAS REFERENCE YOUR 807 As Commander in Chief of Allied Forces, I wish to announce the formation of the Allied Control Commission for Italy which, following the Italian surrender, has today assumed the duty of carrying out the terms of the armistice and of aligning Italian economy in complete support of the United Nations fight against Germany.

Major General Henryn A. Joyce, USA, has been appointed action Deputy President of the Allied Control Commission with headquarters at the seat of the Italian Government. He is the active head of the Control Commission, operating directly under the Commander in Chief of Allied Forces to whom he is responsible. The Commission has control of the military and economic activities of Italy, as envisaged in the terms of the armistice.

Italy has a new role in the war. That role is to fight the common enemy - Germany. The Control Commission will see that all of Italy's economic resources and manpower are utilized where they can do the most good in that fight.

In all areas behind the combat zones, Allied Military Government of enemy territory will gradually be replaced by Italian administration exercised under supervision of the Control Commission. We look to Italian Government to broaden it's

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political competition and strengthen its administrative structure, and the transfer from Allied Military Government to Italian Administration will keep pace with this development. This does not mean the return of Italian territory to unrestricted Italian control.

Allied military government still goes forward with the 15th Army Group to organize the territory as the Germans are expelled. Allied Military Government
..... continued

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continues to press onward as a spearhead, taking charge of communities disorganized by the Nazi retreat and destruction, restoring civic life once burdened with Fascism, and clearing the path immediately for further military movements towards the front.

When the Armistice was granted, the Allied Commander-in-Chief appointed a military mission headed by Lieutenant General F. H. Mason MacFarlane to the Italian Government. It functioned at the temporary seat of the Italian Government, and the scope of the mission corresponded to many of the duties of the Allied Control Commission. The Mission's duties have been performed as planned, and is now replaced by the Allied Control Commission.

General MacFarlane, who has rendered outstanding service, is returning to his post as Governor of Gibraltar.

Well in advance of the surrender, plans were made and personnel brought forward so that we should be prepared for the problems of post-armistice control. The Allied Control Commission was established. It is divided into four sections: one Military; two Political; three Economic and Administrative; four Communications. Each section with its proper sub-divisions will operate in fields as indicated by the titles.

Personnel was drawn from especially qualified military officers and civilian experts. Some of them were sent to this theater for duties involving civil affairs. Others are technicians. Others were engaged in Allied Military Government work.

In all of this change it should be borne in mind that the Italian Government is bound by the terms of the Armistice which stipulate that "the Commander-in-Chief

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of Allied Forces reserves to himself the right to take any measures which in his opinion may be necessary for the protection of the interests of the Allied Forces for the prosecution of the war, and the Italian Government binds itself to take such administrative or other action as the Commander-in-Chief may require."

Pursuant to the Agreement reached at the Tripartite Conference at Moscow, an advisory Council for Italy has been established in conjunction with the work of the Allied Control Commission for Italy. The Advisory Council will deal with day to day questions other than military preparations and will make recommendations to coordinate Allied policy with regard to Italy. In the first instance the Advisory Council will be composed of representatives of the United States, the United Kingdom, the Soviet Union, and the French Committee of National Liberation. Later representatives of Greece and Yugoslavia will be added to this Council.

The United Nations are converting Italy into an effective instrument of war against Germany. They look to the Italian Government to produce tangible results. By rallying the entire people to a vigorous resistance to the Germans, the government of Italy may hasten the redemption of its country and prove its value to the United Nations."

A reply has been received from the Combined Chiefs of Staff in answer to our request for guidance, reference our 6115, indicating that the proposal that Badoglio carry on till Rome is reached is acceptable. TO MARSH MACEFARLANE FROM SIXTH ARMY
OUTSIDE PHOENIX. Reference your 817, 818, 819, our 6115. This is para one. The following are, therefore, the answers to your 3 questions in 819: (a) The temporary solution is acceptable. No conflict with Moscow decisions. (b) We should not undertake to determine Badoglio's policy with respect to publicity. With regard to you yourself and statements emanating from the Allied Mission, in accordance with previous instructions, you are to refrain from anything except general guidance to the press as your judgement may indicate that this is required. We do not propose to exercise political censorship nor to express opinion on internal Italian political matters. (c) It is a matter entirely for Badoglio's decision whether or not he sends for Sforza. You should not suggest it nor take any initiative in arranging a meeting between them. In no case should any member of the Mission act as an intermediary or influence in any way their decisions. ⁰⁰⁰⁰Paratwo. I fully appreciate the delicate political situation existing in Italy. However, it should always be remembered that we are prepared ourselves to continue the exercise of Military Government and have the machinery for this purpose. Our policy should be to refrain from interference in Italian internal affairs except as they deviate from the policies enunciated by the President and the Prime Minister with respect to Italy. It is

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our sincere hope that the Italians will be able to get together and establish a broad based coalition Government and this is the desire of the United Nations. If they are unable to do this and disagreement continues, the obvious alternative is the continuation of Military Government. Para three. Military necessity makes it impossible for the Italian Government to move to Naples. All available facilities in Naples and the immediate vicinity will be required for the operation of our base port and our various headquarters. If facilities for the Government can be found in Sorrento or elsewhere, there is no objection to the move, but the move must be predicated on our approval of the location.

The Italian Governor of Leros, Admiral Mascherpo, has received message from the Italian Supreme Command which states that the functions and post of Governor of Leros are taken over by the British Commander. It also informs him that he is under operational command of the British Commander to whom he is to give full and unreserved co-operation.

Mascherpo has invitation from CINC Levant to conference in Alexandria.

Mascherpo admits British Command and promises full cooperation and continued obedience to orders and proclamations with proviso that governorship is not handed over on grounds that he was appointed by the King. If this proviso is insisted upon General Hall is of opinion that Mascherpo and most of senior officers should resign. Admiral Mascherpo refuses to attend conference with CINC Levant which practically amounts to disobedience of orders.

Italian Navy must replace Mascherpo earliest, and replacement must go to Leros with no pretensions to governorship. Owing to Mascherpo sheltering behind King's replacement should have definite instructions to this effect from King or Regent and also for Mascherpo's removal. Meanwhile have agreed to General Hall accepting present situation

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temporarily. Situation not satisfactory but because of probability of imminent battle in next few days I cannot afford a crisis which would precipitate unrest among other Italian Officers and corresponding lowering of Italian Morale. A protocol in revision of the "Terms of Surrender" as approved by Great Britain, United States and Soviets has been received. (To Fatima for MacFarlane signed Eisenhower cite FMRS) Its text follows:

"Protocol. It is agreed that the title of the document signed at Malta on September 29, 1943 by Marshal Pietro Badoglio, Head of the Italian Government, and General Dwight D. Eisenhower, Commander-in-Chief Allied Forces, should be changed to quote additional conditions of Armistice with Italy." The following further amendments to this document are also agreed:

"In the first paragraph of the Preamble the words "acting in the interests of all the United Nations" are inserted between the words "governments" and "on the other hand". The paragraph in question therefore reads as follows:
"Whereas in consequence of an Armistice dated September 3rd, 1943 between the United States and United Kingdom Governments acting in the interests of all the United Nations on the one hand, and the Italian Government on the other hand, hostilities were suspended between Italy and United Nations on certain terms of a Military Preamble."

In the fourth paragraph of the Preamble the words "and Soviet" are inserted

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between the words "United Kingdom" and "Governments", and the word "and" between the words "United States" and "United Kingdom" is deleted. The paragraph in question therefore reads as follows: "The following, together with ¹² their terms of the Armistice of September 3rd, 1943, are the terms on which the United States, United Kingdom and Soviet Governments, acting on behalf of the United Nations, are prepared to suspend hostilities against Italy so long as their military operations against Germany and the Allies are not obstructed and Italy does not assist these powers in any way and complies with the requirements of these governments."

In paragraph six of the Preamble the word "unconditionally" is inserted between the word "accepted" and "by". The paragraph in question therefore reads as follows: "and have been accepted unconditionally by Marshal Pietro Badoglio, Head of the Italian Government representing the Supreme Command of the Italian land, sea and air forces and duly authorized to that effect by the Italian Government."

In Article 12 the word "unconditionally" is deleted. The Article in question therefore reads as follows: "The Italian land, sea and air forces where-ever located hereby surrender."

Article 29 is amended to read as follows: "Benito Mussolini, his chief Fascists associates, and all persons suspected of having committed war crimes or analogous offences whose names appear on lists to be communicated by the United Nations and who now or in the future are on territory controlled by the Allied Military Command or by the Italian Government, will forthwith be apprehended and surrendered into the hands of the United Nations. Any instructions given by

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the United Nations to this purpose will be complied with." Signatures and date to follow. The foregoing instrument is only acceptable on condition that the Cunningham agreement with respect to the employment of the Italian Navy is amended as follows: 1. The following phrase to be added to the Preamble: "It is understood and agreed that the provisions of this agreement as to immediate employment and disposition of Italian warships and merchant ships do not affect the right of United Nations to make such other dispositions of any or all Italian ships as they may think fit. Their decisions in this respect will be notified to the Italian Government from time to time." 2. Final sentence of last paragraph to be amended to read "will be manned so far as possible by crews provided by Italian Ministry of Marine and will fly the Italian flag." If you do not have complete text of Cunningham agreement it is in hands of Admiral McGrigor. You should have Admirals McGrigor and De Courten come to Brindisi and the protocol and the amendments to the Cunningham agreement to be signed simultaneously. Authority is hereby given you to sign the protocol for the Commander-in-Chief, Allied Forces and for Admiral McGrigor to sign the amendments to the Cunningham agreement. C-in-C Mediterranean concurs.

It is considered essential that these documents be signed with the least possible delay especially in the light of the political situation and the possibility that Badoglio may not long remain as Prime Minister. It should be pointed out to him that the early signature of these instruments will enhance his personal situation as his signature is already affixed to a document which in his opinion is less favorable. In the event that Badoglio asks for any alternative he should be told that these amendments are final.

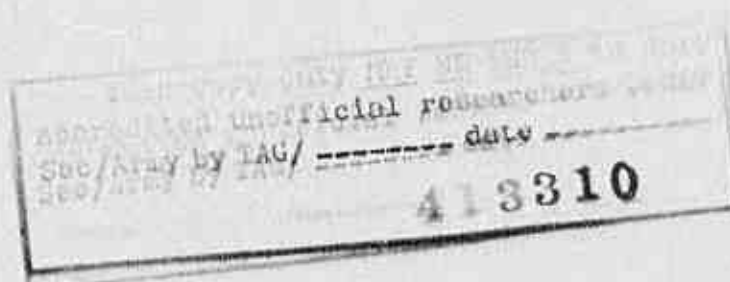

Telegram number 19 November 4 for Radoglio from Dajeta follows. FATIMA FROM MURPHY

and active German propaganda the majority of Gerusalemme now openly opposed to the
Royal Government. This is confirmed to me by Anglo American sources. In executing
the given instructions this creates the main obstacle. Lack of Royal Representative
in Lurengo Marques increases difficulties as well as the fact that even with money
made available by British and Americans the Consular Agent in Baira is incapable of
reestablishing discipline among the crew. If Portuguese British or American
authorities exerted direct persuasive action on the dissident crew they would
encounter difficulties. I therefore suggest that I send a Representative of this
Legation from Portugal by Anglo American airline. I am insisting that the
Portuguese Government maintain close watch and protection over the vessel. In San
Vicente Cape Verde similar situation exists with ship Gerarchia tankers Arcols and
Taigute and is aggravated by presence of dissidents in crews on board. It seems
reasonable to fear sabotage and to prevent this danger there is little the Consular
Agent can do. The Portuguese Government has assured me that it will take every

I believe we could take advantage of the special case of Campini with a view to negotiating the exchange of some other official of similar family status and rank who is now in territory occupied by the Germans or in Germany. It might be possible to send Campini there if such negotiations should be successful. The British and Americans are in agreement in principle as regards such an exchange. I intend to present the matter as outlined to the Swiss Legation here unless I receive contrary instructions.

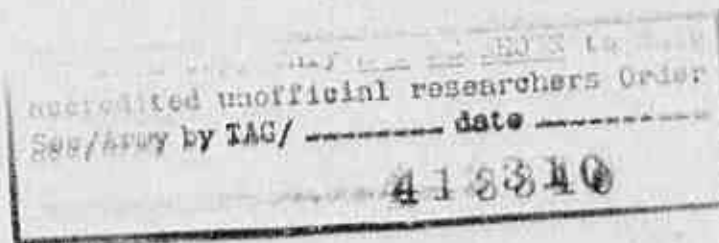

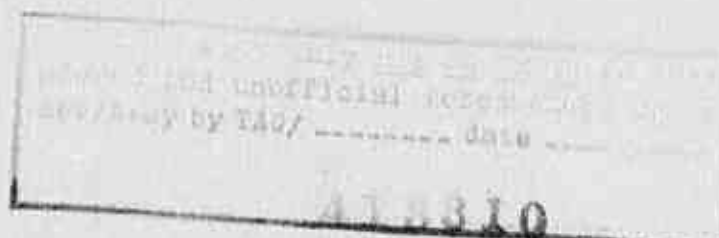

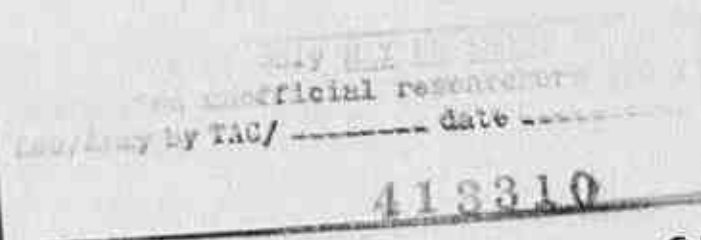

However, the plan for usage includes allotment of time to Italian Government when installed. The location of this station is now under consideration by this Headquarters. Para. Referring your 739 November 3 on same subject we are asking troopers whether any further equipment from British sources can be made available. Our understanding is that there is a general shortage of high powered types in which case the present plan outlined to you in PWBS 4361 October 30 represents in our opinion the most effective compromise between the urgent requirements of the Italian Government and the usually urgent requirements of propaganda to the enemy.

TO MARK(?) REFD FATIMA FOR ADVISOR LINDEN EISENHOWER CITE VISAS. See our ETO of 5th September and your reply of 16th September. AGAIN again stress the extreme importance of this inquiry and request a further examination.

It is considered that foremost factor in realizing maximum output, subject to availability of mulberry leaves only, is price. Following steps should be taken therefore: (A) Get estimate of condition of mulberry trees and appraisal of maximum attainable production cocoons from Italian provincial agricultural offices in Naples, Cosenza, Catanzaro, Reggio Calabria, Pessine, so to devise distribution of silk worm egg; (B) Because no deficiency of labor anticipated if price offered is sufficient, start of study to fix price where greatest utilization will be attained. Price to be determined and publicized by time of distribution of silkworm eggs. However London and Washington desire to be advised before announcing price decision to potential growers.

It is essential to arrange silk wormseed distribution to peasants early in 1944 if there is any evidence that an industry exists.

10,000 boxes silk worm seed in Turkey have been offered for immediate sale to British Ministry of Supply. They must avail themselves of this opportunity at once if at all. This would partially take care of south Italian and Sicilian requirements at

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Advise urgently if true that imported seed will be useful or necessary and if distribution of seeds to peasants can be arranged by 30 November in order that British may decide to purchase or not. This distribution will have to be finished by end February.

Background facts follow: before depression as high as 50,000 metric tons cocoons were produced in Italy, of which Sicily and southern Italy furnished 2,000 tons. Prices fell to 2 lire a KG from average 15 lire a KG when production diminished greatly due to rayon and Japanese competition. Through area(?) distribution of eggs, price subsidies, protective legal rulings etc., government effected 10 year recovery. In 1941 nominal prices attained predepression level, but meanwhile prices had advanced generally and agricultural prices had undergone a 3 to 4 fold increase. Despite government subsidies and endeavors, production never reached capacity because could not obtain predepression real prices for cocoons.

Request you investigate position with best available technical advice treating inquiry as most urgent and important.
