These beds intended for wounded Partisan troops not for civilian refugees. Yugoslav medical personnel with Major Richards rans and equipment already sent should in conjunction with Italian Hospitals cater for sick civilian refugees. Prefer you keep the 150 Military sick and wounded until Barletta ready about fortnight hence but if remaining 450 beds filled earlier the 150 patients may be transferred 70 General Hospital.

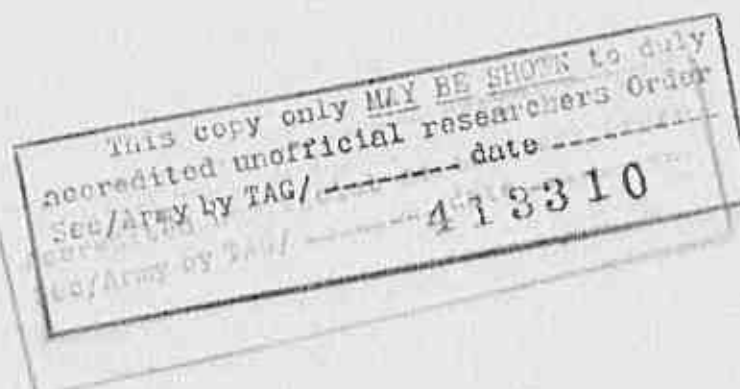

Military Mission understands that up to 8000 mules formerly belonging to Italian army were dispersed among Sicilian civilian population so that withdrawal of some 2400 mules should not affect adversely economics of the Island also any further demands for mules from Italian Army will necessitate our taking mules etc. for unit (moves) and unless more mules are purchased we would be forced to exchange vers for mules. Accordingly we are informing Jung that purchase may be made and that any necessary currency will be provided. End S. Townsend concerned that this will upset our own buying programme. As purchase of all mules outside Italian mainland is controlled by you grateful you issue instructions that no direct purchase of mules will be made by the Italian Army and that demands from them should be submitted to this Hq. which will decide priority of release in light of availability and needs of Allied forces.
