Your attention is invited to the Directive of the CCS in FAN 248 that "the nationalities of heads of the sub-commissions will be left to your decision and, ~~xxx~~ in so far as possible, these posts will be distributed equally between the U.S. and U.K. The assistant heads will similarly be of opposite nationality". It is noted that parity is well maintained at top level of Vice Presidents and Directors, but that as at present recommended, of 22 heads of sub-commissions 17 are British and 5 are American. It is recognized that this is a situation that has developed gradually and is not of your making, but consider it essential to adjust distribution of these appointments to approximate parity.

G-2 SUMMARY

1. No special summary yesterday.
2. EIGHT ARMY. No enemy activity. Total enemy forces from Adriatic to inclusive Alfedana estimated equivalent to some three Infantry Divisions with about 20 Infantry Battalions. Line up is 1 Parachute Division (less 4 or 5 battalions in West), 146 Infantry Regiment (2 battalions only as II Battalion left with 65 Infantry Division), bulk 305 Infantry Division, 334 Infantry Division, remainder 305 Infantry Division.
3. FIVE ARMY. Enemy still resisting tenaciously and counter attacking north and northwest Cassino, evidently determined maintain Monte Cairo as this feature part of reserve line Fondi - Pontecorvo - Aquino - Monte Cairo which according prisoners is being strenuously prepared. Enemy employing civilians, prisoners, (Toet ? rpt Toet ?) personnel and foreigners. Latter possible GBT units or Slovak formation recently reported brought down from Rimini Area to work in rear Cassinik Line. No indications however that enemy preparing to abandon forward Gustav Line. Central Sector quiet. Enemy holding strongly in lower Gerigliano Sector. Line up from West Coast is now 94 Infantry Division, 29 PG Division, 15 PG Division (last 2 battalions in Bridgehead Area), 90 PG

Division(supported by 3 or 4 battalions of 71 Infantry Division, a parachute and 1 or 2 independent mountain battalions), 44 Infantry Division (believed very depleted but supported by 8 PGR of 3 PG Divisions) and 5 Mountain Division.

4. VI Corps R enemy remains generally passive on flanks though occasional attempts made to cross Mussolini Canal. On main front general increase in aggressiveness has followed recent successes south of Campoleone and Cisterna but attacks have not been co-ordinated or pressed home. Indications that stronger and more general attack preparing. Tank reinforcements reported and much traffic south of Rome. Enemy artillery now covering whole depth of Bridgehead. Medium artillery mainly Aret Lamuvic (F9142), heavy artillery including IX 210 mm Area Cori (G 0938). Total build up equivalent 6 divisions; namely, 65 and 715 Infantry, 26 and Hermann Goering Panzer, and 3 PG Divisions, also miscellaneous elements from 1 and 4 parachute, 15 PG, 71 Infantry and 114 Jaeger Division. Consider 71 Infantry Division probably operating a sector with ~~other units~~ other units subordinate to compensate for those elements on main 5 Army Front. Recent identification infantry element 114 Jaeger Division suggests this formation likely to arrive piecemeal as it gets free from Partisans. Consider original identification elements 29 PG Division due proximity such units at time of landing. Appreciate bulk of Division now on main front. Unconfirmed reports of arrival reinforcements of heavy tanks.

(1) Prisoner reports Hq 356 Infantry Division at Alessandria with 869 Regiment at Savouj.

(2) Concerning Hitler's reference in his recent order to important political consequences of successful defense of Gustav Line, recent prisoner states common rumour that Hitler is at present negotiating with Stalin and is

Reference DCAC 8800 of 12 Jan.

1. You will have seen our 42202 of 24 Jan regarding the use of Papal seminaries for hospitals.

2. The following general considerations are operative:

(A) In virtue of our military occupation of all south Italy we are entitled to requisition any property required for military or similar purposes. This right is independent of our rights under the Armistice and is not affected by the fact that an Italian Civil Administration may be functioning in the district concerned: It is also in no way affected by the Lateran Treaty.

(B) For political reasons it is desirable that in districts administered by the Italian Government any requisition of Papal property should be effected by the Italian authorities on our behalf.

(C) It is also desirable that the Vatican should be informed that a requisition of their property in southern Italy is being carried out. It is not however necessary to obtain the Vatican's consent in advance.

(D) In view of the President's message of July 10, which amounts to an undertaking that the Allied authorities will treat Vatican property throughout Italy as having extra territorial character, it is essential that force should not be used either by the Allied Military authorities or by the Italian authorities on their behalf, to eject the occupants from requisitioned premises which are the property of the Vatican.

3. In the case of the Molfetta seminary, premises have been duly requisitioned by Italian Government (see Fatima 1958 of Jan 13), and Vatican have been notified by British Minister. Only obstacle is difficulty in finding alternative accommodation for occupants which is possibly increased by their unco-operative attitude. Instructions from the Vatican to the Archbishop of Bari to co-operate with the Allied Military authorities in arranging for the handover of the seminary were contained in letter to Allied Control Commission MAC-386. 2 of 18 Dec. If further instructions to the Archbishop are to be sent it is essential that a reply from him to the Vatican's communication should first be obtained (see Freedom cable to Fatima rear 15323 of 31 Jan)

4. As regards pescevento seminary, there is no reason why requisition should not be imposed forthwith. This Headquarters should be informed by cable of action being taken in order that arrangements may be made for British Minister to notify the Vatican. Alternative accommodation will have to be found for the inmates. If any message or instructions from the Vatican are required, this Headquarters will endeavour to obtain them through the British Minister.

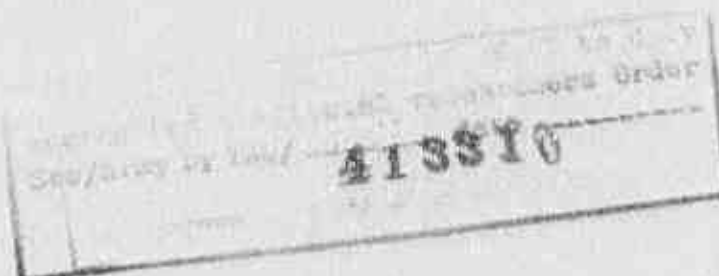

The ensuing is a paraphrase of message received this Headquarters today through Squadron Leader Johnson from Main 8th Army to GSI (B) HQ ACMF cite I 1713 (264) for Higson from Defreitas.

Lt Gen Gianantoni MVSN landed at San Vito 29 January having escaped by water from enemy territory together with Lt Augusto Riccardi and Sgt Majors Michele Cruspino and Incenzo Paolin. The General was subjected to special IA questions at this Headquarters but the results were meagre. As a result of a misunderstanding the General and his companions by passed RIF and west to Brindisi by way of Bari. ETA Brindisi on the evening 2 February. The General gave out that he intended to interview the King and to reorganize Italian Armed Forces so as to be in a position to resist the Germans. He maintains that his sentiments are anglophile. The good faith of Gianantoni is strongly suspected. It is possible that he was sent by RIF to learn the extent of Italian cooperation. It is suggested that his movements be checked. The 2 NCOs are being trailed by SIM NCO with the object of investigating certain suspect activities. Letter follows.

It is believed Gianantoni is now in Brindisi and is suggested De Franco C. SIM also believed to be in Brindisi will be of assistance to you in your search.

PARSO REQUESTING FATIMA ROAD AND FAIRBANKS

Herewith reply to your message CITE Perso 695 of 1 February and to memorandum 12/0/33 of same date with its inclosures.

1. Document A, Article 1 must stand as written. Under Article 13 of long terms the Italian Government must make certain things available in occupied territory. Although the territory restored becomes "non-occupied", we reserve, nevertheless, the rights stipulated in Article 1 of Document A.

2. Document A, Article 9. Redraft cannot be accepted. However, you are authorized to add at end of Article 9 these words "except as may from time to time be agreed by the Allied Powers."

3. Document A, Article 11. Redraft cannot be accepted. But you may alter old sentence to begin "any official or other representative of, in respect of any activities for official account, any agency of the United Nations, civilian or military" etc.

4. Document A, Article 13. Desired amendment cannot be accepted. Document A speaks of the restored territory as being "non-occupied." Italian amendment would limit costs recoverable to those arising from troops connected with "occupation".

5. Document C. Separation into three parts as described is acceptable.

6. Document C, Article 3. Your comment is approved. You may omit

For the past five months it has been necessary for this legation to provide not only for all offices of the diplomatic and consular services, technical attaches professors and teachers and employees in Switzerland but also for all customs state railways and police personnel who in considerable number remain in Switzerland. Support of Italian officials at Compiene is not also necessary. Paraphrase of magistrati's number 10 urgent for Royal Ministry Foreign Affairs referring his number eight of January 13. The financial situation this legation is extremely delicate and can hardly be protected. This is result of these obligations together with those necessitated by aid to Italian refugees to Switzerland. Cable urgently whether in accord with co-belligerent countries Royal government is providing the expected payment of 250000 Swiss Francs monthly for this legation and Consular offices.

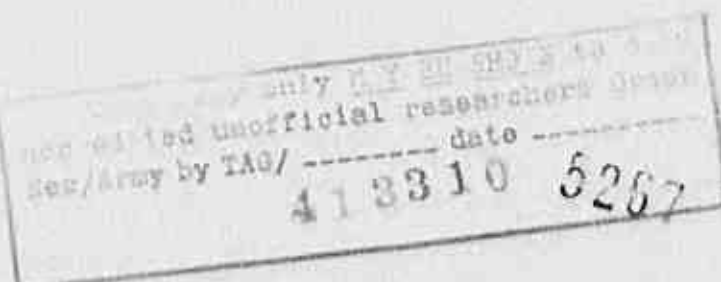

G-2 SUMMARY PARAPHRASE BY FREEDOM

1. No special summary since 28 January.
2. EIGHT ARMY. No enemy activity reported. Resistance strong on Tollo Axis. Recent changes in front line units have made no appreciable change in forward positions.
3. FIVE ARMY. Enemy continues to contest strongly penetration southwest of Cairo and north of Cassino. Central sector generally quiet and shelling lessening; lower Garigliano opposition heaviest area Maviano and west of Mignano. No indications any slackening in enemy's stubborn defensive but believe his forces considerably stretched. No known Corps reserves apart from elements of divisions engaged in line. Enemy consequently unable to thicken up in one sector without thinning in another. Recent identifications however show determination to make use of every available unit to maintain the line and to enable action against Anzio Bridgehead to mature in security.
4. SIX CORPS. Enemy evidently resolved to contain bridgehead in present form. Resistance heavy at Stazioni di Cavapoletto and Giarma and on line of railway between. Pressure on Allied left flank more solid. Enemy observing and maintaining contact with Allied right flank. Estimate total enemy build up now probably equivalent of nearly 5 divisions. No indications yet of major counterattack. Enemy probably intends complete his preparations and overcome administrative complications before undertaking large scale operation.
5. Personalities. PW states Kesselring appointed G-in-C southwest last November. His chief of staff is Westphal. Captured document shows von Hoffmann Chief of Staff 1 Parachute Corps.

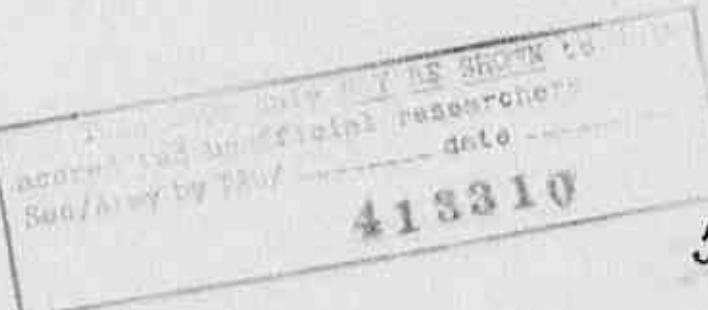
1. Following was intended by paragraph 4 our MBs OMO-1 of 20 January. On resumption foreign mails IRCC delegations in Italy will send correspondence of all nature through normal post offices in precisely same manner other organizations in Italy who wish to correspond overseas. Mail should be addressed to IRCC Delegation, Algiers, at same address as indicated in our letter under reference, and will be subject censorship here. On receipt by IRCC Delegation here mail will be sorted and consigned ultimate destinations under arrangements IRCC. Mail should not be consigned direct to Switzerland or any other country, but should only be despatched as above.

2. Regarding outlet for Eastern Europe via Turkey. This is matter for IRCC Delegation, Algiers, who will handle IRCC correspondence for all destinations.

3. Now subject. We have not advised Region 1 of address for foreign mail bags destined Gibraltar, but gave details here personally to Major Head who was to issue necessary instructions.
