SUBJECT: Violation of Cryptographic Security.

TO : Acting Deputy President, Allied Control Commission, FATIMA.

1. FATIMA message number 903, 12 November 1943, involved a serious violation of cryptographic security in that it contained an exact quotation of a statement to be released to the press and to be given over the radio in Italian. It was enciphered in a SECRET cryptographic system which is used throughout the theater. The proposed release without paraphrasing is a direct violation of paragraph 35 g, AR 380-5.

2. Future statements of this nature that require classification prior to release to the public, if transmitted in cipher, must be paraphrased in accordance with paragraph 39, AR 380-5, prior to such release, or as an alternate, a paraphrased version of the text may be filed for transmission. It is recommended that such material be handled by Air Dispatch Letter Service (ADLS) whenever possible, thereby avoiding the necessity for such paraphrasing.

3. It is requested that the above be drawn to the attention of all concerned in order to prevent the recurrence of such a violation.

Double transposition cipher book method described in letter from Col. Henderson dated 6 October as modified below is authorized for use by Italians. FOR SIGNALS FATIMA SIGNED CINC CITE FREIG. Under conditions given. Different keys will be used for each transposition requiring two four (24) number groups each consisting of a page and line number, 1 for each transposition. Enciphering additive for indicators will consist of 8 numbers selected at random and will be held by all holders of each system. Additive will change twice daily. The book used for keys will when possible be a new novel. Message lengths will be kept between limits of 100 and 250 groups of five letters. Short messages will be padded to make up the minimum length. Padding will consist of random words. Long messages will be cut into parts with lengths between limits given. Completely filled rectangles will not be used for either transposition. No effort will be made to make messages an exact multiple of five. Stereotyped phraseology will be carefully avoided. Books used for keys will be changed at frequent intervals. 1 copy of all keys and key books used will be furnished the US Cipher Team at Fatima. 2 copies of all keys and key books used will be furnished the Signal Intelligence Service AFHQ with a list of all holders of each system.

All messages to be cleared through control commission, who hold copy of cipher keys. Required that 2 copies of all keys used by Italian Government be furnished GSO AFHQ. This cipher not suitable for tactical use. Was not deemed necessary furnish you copy instructions since cipher intended primarily for high level use under supervision of Control Commission.
