INFORMATION FROM REFUGEES.

1. Present position.

a. Land.

There are still a considerable number of refugees coming south from Occupied Italy. These consist of both military and civil personnel the latter containing many interesting people such as diplomats chemist and various officials and technicians who have considerable information at their disposal.

There are many thousands of military and civil refugees already in camps who have also come from Occupied Italy. The civilians in camps consist of allied national and not Italians. The latter apparently once over the line disperse far and wide in search of shelter and jobs. At the moment they are lost sight of. The military are keeping newly arrival military refugees in camps where they are to be organized into units. One example of this is at LECCE where there are 10,000 troops in camps waiting to be organized.

b. Sea.

Many refugees come from Occupied Italy by sea and are on landing becoming refugees under similar conditions to those under sub para 1 a above.

In addition refugees are continually arriving by sea at all points along the coast from the Balkans. These consist of both military and civil personnel of all Balkan and Italian nationality. Some of all of these categories are directed into appropriate camps and others appear to land and then go where they please without any control or checking.

c. Air.

A few refugees are arriving by air. One recent example has been the arrival of ten Croat airmen in German uniforms and in German planes at Brindisi.

Conclusion.

There is no security control nor any means of collecting any information available.

2. Allied and Italian Organizations concerned with these questions.

a. Allied.

From an intelligence and security point of view these are the concern of the Allied Intelligence Services.

From a national point of view all nationals of the Allied Nations are the concern of the Prisoners of War Sub-Commission known as the Venables Commission which is responsible for reception in Allied Occupied Italy and for the eventual evacuation elsewhere.

b. Italians.

From an intelligence and security point of view these types of refugees are of interest to the Allied and Italian Intelligence Services.

" Italian From a national point of view they are the responsibility of the military or civil organization concerned in Allied Occupied Italy.

3. Suggested plan.

a. Allied nationals.

As it is the concern of the Venables Commission to look after these types of refugees and as the Venables Commission already has some intelligence officers sent out either by the War Office or COSMIC officers sent out by AFHQ, it is recommended as an interim measure that all questioning and security checking is carried out by this organization and that people with information of special interest are sent back to a point where they are accessible if not already sufficiently so, with an officer speaking the language concerned so that they can be questioned by the Allied Intelligence Service.

By leaving the preliminary interrogation in the hands of the Venables Commission the interesting people can be sorted out quickly with the present staff available. The detailed talks would necessarily have to be undertaken through a Venables Commission Intelligence Officer by the Allied Intelligence Service.

b. Italians.

Just behind each Army area a preliminary interrogation post or posts should be set up at which are Italian Officers and later if possible Allied Officers. These officers would be in liaison with the Army H.Q. Intelligence and would pass back to them anything of interest obtained. Questionnaires would be supplied in the first place by Army Group with supplementary questions added by Army Hq Intelligence as required. These questionnaires would be changed from time to time according to requirements.

These posts would also be able to pick out all those persons with interesting information to give. These should be sent back to Detailed Interrogation Centres where they could be questioned at length. From these they could then be passed to the Italians for disposal into Military camps or as required. If the information was of interest without being dependent on time then the person could be sent back to the camp or other place of disposal after their full particulars and future location had been obtained, so that members of the Allied Intelligence Services could question them at length.

It is recommended that at the moment two of these Detailed Interrogation centres be set up one at BARI and the other at NAPLES. At both these places facilities exist at the local "Tappa" or reception camp.

For the moment the Interrogation post behind V Army and the Detailed Interrogation Centre at NAPLES could be both combined until operations necessitate a move forward of the interrogation post.

The personnel required to start these posts and centres would be two Italian Officers at each Interrogation Post and one at BARI. It is recommended that one Allied Officer is also at each Interrogation post and at least one British or American CSBIC Officer at each Detailed Interrogation Centre.

Questionnaires for Detailed Interrogation Centres would be supplied by AFHQ to which supplementary questions could be added by Army Group if and when required.

All Services of the Allied Forces could submit questionnaires through the present Italian Intelligence Sources Sub-Committee who in turn would coordinate the questions to be sent to the detailed Interrogation Centers.

If possible Interrogation posts and detailed Interrogation centres should be in touch by Radio, but this will not be possible for security reasons until the communications can be run by Allied personnel. It is suggested that the radio organization understood to be with the Mobile CSBIC section now on its way here could be used for this.

Detailed Interrogation centres could be in telephonic communication with Army Group or with V Army Hq. Intelligence as the case may be. normal

Further communication rearwards can be by means of the ~~normal~~ methods.

Both Interrogation Centres and detailed Interrogation centres could be reasonably mobile and should have at least one car.

Camps will have to be erected at Interrogation Centres and ~~staright~~ possibly at Interrogation Posts. This would have to be the responsibility of the Italians. The only Allied responsibility would be to send persons with important information back as far as the Detailed Interrogation Centres. afterwards their disposal would be an Italian responsibility.

From the security point of view Security and carabinieri Officers could be at both Interrogation Posts and at Detailed Interrogation Centres which could serve the same purpose from both an intelligence and a security point of view, the Interrogation Post separating the important people from the rest who could then be disposed of according to the wishes of the Italians. The important persons would then go back in Allied transport to the detailed Interrogation centres where they could be further questioned from an intelligence or from a security point of view.

The Italians intend to start their detailed Interrogation Centres staright away at BARI and NAPLES strait away.

The locations and final details of the Interrogation posts are being decided by 15 Army group.

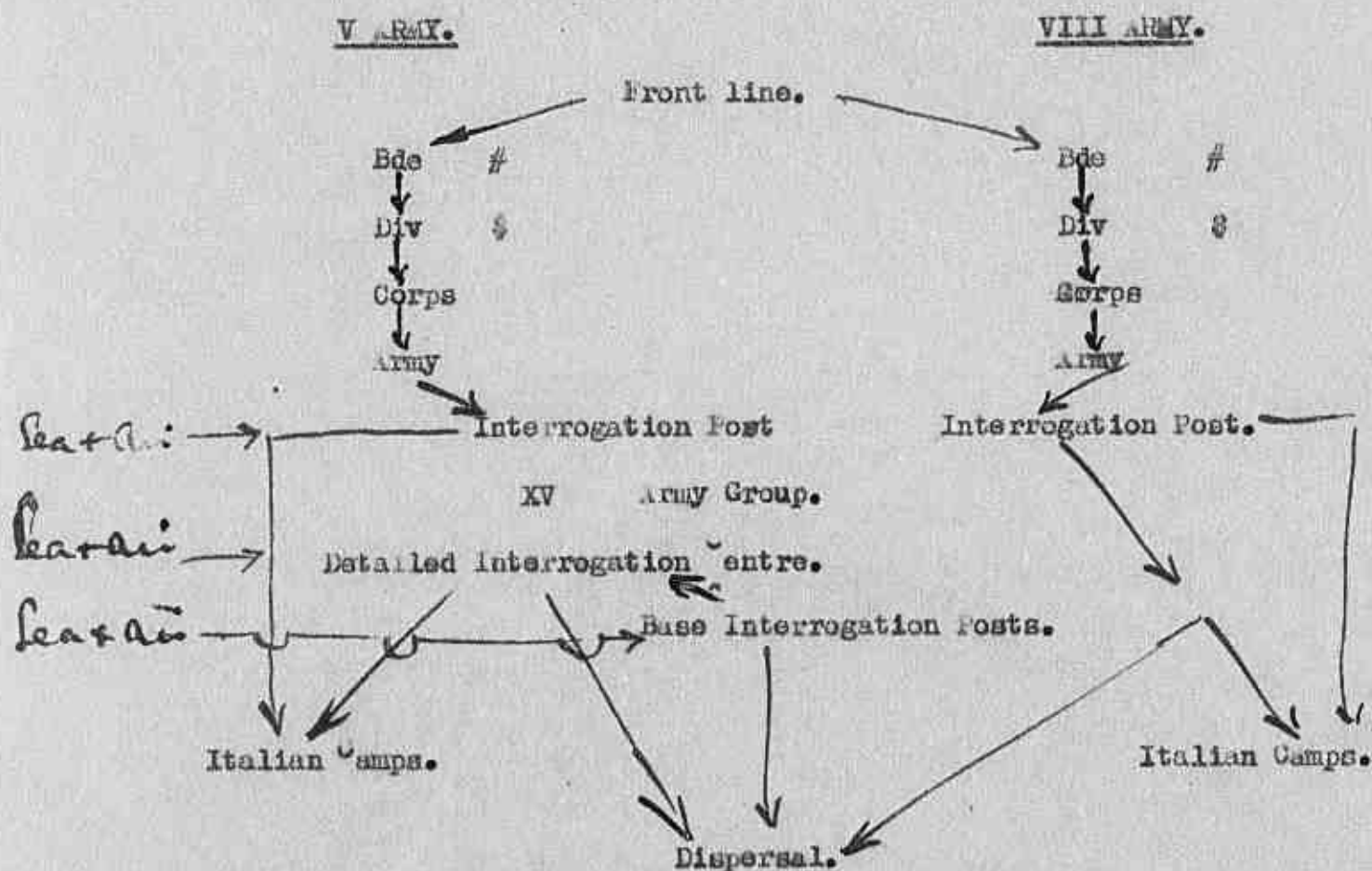
All refugees not coming through Army Areas could be directed to the nearest Interrogation Post or Port security Section who could also act as a Base Interrogation Post. Detailed Interrogation Centres could also serve as Interrogation posts for those persons who first arrived in Italy nearest to them. This would apply to all refugees arriving by land sea or air.

Division of Responsibility.

1. Attached are two appendices showing the division of responsibility for collating operational intelligence, except naval and air, between G-2, AFHQ and G.S.(I), Middle East, as a result of the unified command.

2. This division of responsibility may be subject to alteration in the light of experiences, and in the development of operations. It is realised that some duplication will be inevitable but it is hoped that this has been reduced to a minimum. G-2, AFHQ, will from time to time indicate priorities for collation work.

Collection and Dissemination of Intelligence.

3. Agencies and persons responsible for the collection and distribution of information will ensure that those responsible for collation receive the information pertinent to their responsibilities.

4. Collated information on the respective spheres of responsibility will be exchanged between G-2, AFHQ, and G.S.(I), Middle East, as necessary. In this connection, Intelligence Notes on German Army Organisation, training and methods, produced weekly by AFHQ, will be available for issue to formations under command Middle East if desired.

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Technical Intelligence.

5. All technical intelligence obtained in the theater will be distributed by G-2, AFHQ, in the form of periodical technical intelligence summaries. This does not apply to intelligence collected during operations by Middle East, who will disseminate information as necessary.

Security Intelligence.

6. AFHQ will be responsible for defining the security policy to be followed and particularly measures to implement this policy in the whole of the AFHQ area. The channels of control for security measures in regard to projected operations shall in the main be the same as those for operational intelligence.

3. The method of reporting to Advance G-2 (C.I.) A.F.H.Q. is set out in Port Security Instruction No.4 dated 6 January 1944.
4. Any instructions which involve change in policy, will be issued by Advanced G-2 (C.I.) A.F.H.Q. for and on behalf of G-2 (C.I.) A.F.H.Q., but such instructions will be approved by the latter before being issued.
5. Advanced G-2 (C.I.) A.F.H.Q. may issue such instructions to Peninsular Base Section as fall within the framework of Natoussa letter A.G.371.2/162B-0, dated 29 August 1943 as amended by letter of the same reference dated 3 January 1944. Drafts of other instructions thought necessary, will be forwarded to G-2 (C.I.) A.F.H.Q., and action will be taken by the latter in consultation with G-2 Natoussa.
6. Personnel of C.I.C. Airport Control Detachments will shortly be placed on the airports of Bari and Naples. They will be under the operational control of Advanced G-2 (C.I.) A.F.H.Q.
7. Advanced G-2 (C.I.) is authorised to correspond direct with other Headquarters including 15th Army Group and S.I.M.B. on matters falling within their province.
