

My Dear General You will receive a letter from Bob Murphy today about communications with the Italian Ambassador at Madrid I think the letter is quite clear. Marshall Padoglio will, I hope, immediately write the necessary letter, particularly instructing the Ambassador to co-operate with our Ambassador in carrying out all the items of the armistice, especially as regards shipping in Spanish ports. You will observe that this letter must be signed by the Marshall. The letter can be flown back here and A.F.H.Q. will arrange for it to be flown to Gibraltar and then taken to Madrid. I'm afraid the communications are working very badly, but I hope for your sake they will improve. I am taking up the question of AMG Lira at to-morrow's conference. At today's conference we made a report on the present situation, and it was decided to put the whole question of higher policy before the two Governments for decision. I must thank you very much for your kindness and I hope we were not too much of a nuisance. It was a most interesting experience and you can rely on me to back you up in every way I can. Dear General, We have a message from the American Ambassador in Madrid to the effect that the Italian Ambassador in Spain advised him thet since the Italian armistics he has received no instructions. He urgently wishes to receive instructions signed by Marshall Badoglio ordering him to collaborate with the American and British Embassies. as well as for his Military and Naval Attaches to cooperate with their American and British colleagues. According to this advice the Italian Ambassador does not know officially the terms of the armistice. He only knows that an armistice has been signed, that Victor Emmanuel remains King and that Padoglio is Prime Minister. He requests that the armistice terms be communicated to him urgently, as well as instructions regarding Italian shipping now in Spenish parts. The Italian Ambassador is a?r. donb ful regarding any massage which ho might receive in Italian code because he believes that the Italian codes are known to the Germans. You may wish to communicate the foregoing to Marshall Badoglio if this information has not already come to you through any other source. We believe that it would be helpful indeed if written instructions to the Italian Ambassedor signed by Marshall Bidoglio. or some member of his stuff, could be sent to the Italian Ambassador immediately by plane, and relayed to Gibraltar for delivery to him at that place. with cordial good wishes I am, Very sincerely yours. /s/ Robert D. Please inform Badoglio and the King that according to the American representatives there the Italian missions both in Lisbon and Madrid are concerned over the absence of any knowledge regarding the present whereabouts of the Italian Government and the absence of definite to instructions as to the line of policy they are to follow. Ambassador in Madrid points out that a serious problem confronts him in Spain. There are 3,000 Italians in Madrid alone, and his staff. Including Consuls and Agents runs into hundreds. Pressure is being brought to bear on the Consuls to declare for the Fasciat Government by the Germans. Pressure has so far been resisted by all the Consuls who are awaiting instructions. Present indefinite status cannot however continue for long. The Ambassador has heard nothing since the government left Rome and (? does) not even know who is the Minister Foreign Affairs. He is unable to answer the questions of the Italians in Spain who are equally without information and the Ambassador states that he must have some word quickly in order to unite them. He believes he can hold the majority in line if communications are established with his governmental though it is clear that some Italians in Spain will desert to the Fascist Regime. Direct courier service by plane from Gibraltar to the Seat of the Italian Government is solicited. Dajeta in Lisbon has asked that a message be communicated to the King to the effect that he and his collaborators are holding themselves at the Kings disposal and awaiting his orders. Information is further requested concerning the King's general desire withrespect to the functioning of the legation as well as any specific wishes he may have with regard to individual members of the Staff. It has also been suggested that Marshall Badoglio may wish to instruct Italian diplomatic organisations abroad to cooperate with the Allies and place all information concerning Germany at their disposal. Since it may be impractical for him to communicate direct with all Italian diplomatic agents, he may wish to communicate through the Italian Ambassador in Madrid, passing on through him his instructions and the terms of the Armistice for their guidance. The Italians missions have also pointed out that another serious matter is that whereas the radio from Northern Italy, and lately from Rome, assures Italians that the Fascist Government of Italy, no word has come from either the King or Endoglio on the other side, which is naturally disturbing to Italians abroad who feel in need of guidance.

Minister in Lisbon, Signor PRUNAS, the following direct messages of Name the King:

Lieutenenat General Chief of Mission

"The lack of sufficient and proper radio connections has made
it difficult to send my direct word from this free part of peninsular
Italy to the Italians who are in the Country, and to those who abroad
represent in My Name the Royal Government and the Country.

Meanwhile, hoping that direct communications will be established, Your Excellency will kindly transmit my words of unshaken faith to all Compatriots. I trust that I shall soon come back to Rome with my Government. The cordial and powerful help of the valorous anglo-american troops, the numerous proofs of fidelity and attachment which the population has given me with unanimous enthusiasm, the perfect behaviour of all the Armed Forces which remained true to their Oath, are a great comfort to, me in this grave moment.

The Italian Ambassador at Madrid requests that message along following lines be transmitted to BADOGLIO.

His Excellency Marshall Badoglio Chief of the Government of the King of Italy. I have the honour to state the following in reply to your Excellencys message received September 24 through the kindness of the American Ambassador in Madrid.

I am awaiting with devotion His Majestys Message which he has graciously despatched to me and beg ofyour Excellency that you convey to our August Sovereign the hope of expression of unfailing loyalty of myself and that of the whole staff of the Royal Embassy in Spain as well as of the Royal Consulates.

As your Excellency is aware I am in contact with the British Charge d'Affaires and the American Ambassador in order to fully carry out as quickly as possible the instructions sent me by your Excellency and confirmed in the signed letter about the departure of the Royal Nevy Ships and Merchant Ships now in Spanish ports. The matter was discussed this morning with the Spanish Minister for Foreign Affairs and he was requested to accord all facilities possible so that the question could be solved in accordance with your Excellencys instructions. Though he asked for a written request Count Jordana replied that the matter would be dealt with with complete objectivity. And he said further that as Spains neutrality which has special Judicial aspect was involved. It was a very delicate question. I saw my American......

and British Colleagues immediately after the above interview and they agreed that I should prepare the note in consultation with them.

Please be assured you Excellency that all the Staff of this Royal Embassy remain Loyal to His Majesty and will support faithfully yourself in your task. and that except for a few sporadic contrary manifestations all the Italian consulates in Spain are collaborating in the same manner. I have partially settled such contrary manifestations. At the outset I informed the Royal Representatives in Ankara Berne Buenos Aires Dublin Helsinki Kabul Lisbon and Stockholm of the unchanged attitude of my Staff and myself. Aside from Dublin and Kabul from whom I have received no replies I have received telegraphic advices that the same course is being followed. In accord with your Excellencys Orders I have communicated to all the above mentioned representatives your instructions sent for my information and for those representatives that I was able to communicate with. I will immediately despatch any message your Excellency may wish communicated to the above representatives.

I have received telegraphic advices from the Royal Minister that The Legation in Berne continues to deal with the protection of Italian interests in those countries in which we are represented by the Swiss Government.

Messages will be brought to His Majesty and to your Excellency in a few days through the good offices (?) of the American Ambassador in Madrid
