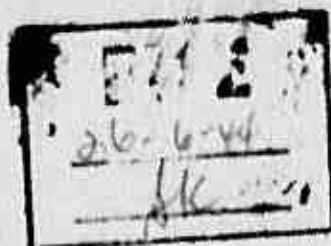
1. 750/2/CA of 5 June 1944 is cancelled.
2. Members of the A.C.C. may now proceed to Rome without passes provided they have obtained permission from the Head of their Section or Independent Sub-Commission.
3. That part of 751/7/CA of 7 June 1944 relating to Italian officials is cancelled. Members of the Italian Government now have permanent passes. Italian officials may be granted passes to travel to Rome by the Secretary General at Naples or Salerno, without reference to the Security Branch, provided assent is given by the Head of the relevant Section or Independent Sub-Commission.

MEMORANDUM FOR: Executive Commissioner, Hq. ACC

1. I have informed the Undersecretary of the Presidency of the Council of Ministers, Sig. Penatua, that Ministerial Undersecretaries now in Rome may now be permitted to enter their respective Ministries. Their functions will be limited to personnel reorganization, "house-keeping", and related organizational problems in order that when the government is transferred from Salerno to Rome, the Ministries will be set up and ready to function. In the meantime, the Government will continue to operate in Salerno.
