TO : All Concerned.

14 June 1944

1. It is essential that the number of deceased persons required to be listed as "Missing in action" because of lack of identification, be kept to the absolute minimum.

2. All commanders will insure that members of their command wear identification tags in accordance with the provisions of AR 600-40.

3. The clothing and equipment of all individuals will be marked in accordance with AR 850-5, the provisions of which are extended to include officer personnel.

SUBJECT: Identification Tags.

TO : All Unit Commanders, this Regiment.



29 May 1944

1. It has come to the attention of the Regimental Commander that entirely too many officers and enlisted men of this organization are being apprehended by military police for failure to wear identification tags. For your information and guidance Paragraph 36, Change 1, AR 600-40, dated 11 August 1942, is quoted:

"36. Tag, identification. Identification tags will be worn by each member of the Army at all times, with either uniform or civilian clothing, and may be removed temporarily only as the necessities of personal hygiene may require; one tag to be suspended from the neck underneath the clothing by a cord or tape 40 inches in length passed through a small hole in the tag, the second tag to be fastened about 2 1/2 inches above the first one on the same cord or tape, both securely held in place by knots. These tags are prescribed as a part of the uniform and will be habitually worn by the owner. The tags, embossed as provided in AR 600-35, will be issued to each member of the Army as soon as practicable after entry into service."

2. Unit Commanders will institute an immediate check to ascertain which members of their units are not complying with the above provisions. Corrective steps will then be taken to insure against any similar violations.

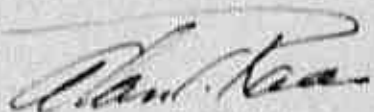
