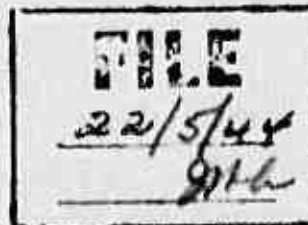

SUBJECT: Direct Appointment as 2d Lieutenant.

TO : All Unit Commanders, this Regiment.



1. All personnel desirous of submitting applications for appointment as 2d Lieutenant, AUS, as provided for in Circular #49, NATCUSA, dated 7 April 1944, will adhere to the following instructions.

a. Company commanders will process any application initiated by a member of their command, in accordance with AR 625-5 and the above-mentioned Circular.

b. Unit commanders will issue instructions that the applicant will indicate in his letter the branch of service in which he would like to serve and reason therefore, and a brief resume of his technical experience, abilities, and position vacancy he could fill if appointed.

c. WD AGO Form #0850 and #0850A in triplicate will be completed. All questions will be answered either in the affirmative or negative.

d. Three letters of recommendation from officers who have personally come in contact with the applicant, his work, and who can attest to or evaluate his abilities will be submitted.

e. The Company commander's indorsement will indicate his approval, applicant's AGCT score, efficiency and character rating, and other pertinent remarks. Statement that soldier has completed six months overseas will also be included in the forwarding indorsement. Application papers disapproved by the Company commander will be returned to the applicant.
