SUBJECT: Jewish Holyday of Passover.

TO : All Concerned.

1. This year the first two days of the Jewish Holyday of Passover begin the evening of April 7th, and the last two days begin the evening of April 13th. The Jewish Holyday begins at sunset and ends at sunset. Passover is celebrated by a Table Service, the Seder, and by worship assembly.

2. Where possible, commanding officers will assist Jewish personnel to hold the Seder by arranging for the use of mess and quartermaster facilities. The Jewish Welfare Board is providing unleavened bread throughout the theater. Chaplains will be acquainted with the procedure of drawing these rations.

3. Within military expediency, appropriate commanders may grant officers and enlisted men of the Jewish faith time off to attend Seder and other Passover worship assemblies.

4. It is desired that the above be brought to the attention of all concerned.
