

SUBJECT: Soldier's Individual Pay Record.

TO : All Units, this Regiment.



1. Section IV, Circular #74, War Department, dated 18 February 1944, is quoted for the guidance of all concerned.

"IV - SOLDIER'S INDIVIDUAL PAY RECORD - 1. Pending the revision of AR 345-155, 15 January 1943, paragraph 12c of those regulations is changed to provide that the bottom line of page 2, WD AGO Form #28, (Soldier's Individual Pay Record) will not be signed by the officer preparing the book. When new books are prepared, either for issue to newly inducted enlisted persons, or as substitutes for lost, damaged, or destroyed books previously issued, this line will be left blank.

2. Immediate action will be taken by all organization commanders to secure from enlisted persons of their organizations soldiers' individual pay records in their possession and will cause the signature of the officer preparing the book which appears on the bottom line of page 2 thereof to be removed by cutting that part of the page bearing the signature of the officer out of the book and destroying it.

3. Signatures of enlisted persons will continue to be entered on page 2 of the soldiers' individual pay records and will not be disturbed during the removal of the signatures on the bottom line."

SUBJECT: Payment of Enlisted Men.

To : All Unit Commanders, 2675th Regt, Allied Central Commandos, (Prov), APO 344, U. S. Army.
