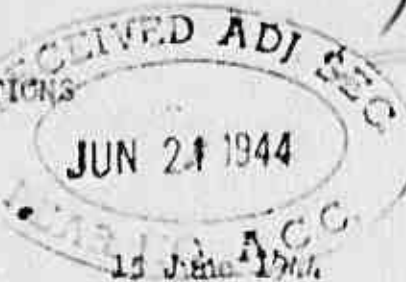

SUBJECT: Restoration to Duty of General Prisoners.

TO : All Concerned.



1. Reports have reached this headquarters that upon the release of general prisoners from confinement from the MATOUSA Disciplinary Training Center and restoration to duty under a suspended sentence, some are being reassigned either to divisions that tried them or to the divisions to which the men were assigned at the time of the commission of the offense resulting in their trial.

2. You are authorized to return to Personnel Centers, any man of this category who was inadvertently sent to his former division contrary to the prescribed policy as set forth in the following letter:
