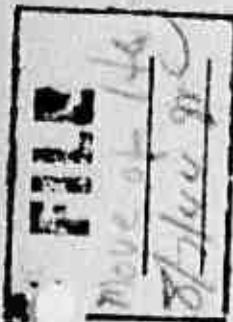

Sub-Commissions will prepare a list of their packages and their senior NCO will check that they are all loaded and hand a copy of the list to the transport officer who will obtain a receipt on his copy on giving delivery of the stores in Rome. He will remain responsible for the stores overnight and will satisfy himself as to their safe custody until delivery.

8 Officers and Officers baggage

Officers are responsible for seeing that their baggage is stacked in the appropriate place at either the Palace of Justice by 0630 hrs or the Hotel Vittoria by 0730 hrs.

Officers living in Salerno will take their places in Lorry B before 0730 hrs. Those living at Cave will take the places allotted to them before 0830 hrs.

Officers are advised to take with them in their cars a haversack or small handbag with kit for the night, in case their kit is not delivered the same night. (The convoy is not due to arrive until about 2300 hrs).

Officers up to rank of Lt Col will probably be located at the Flora, will mark their kit conspicuously F and it will be packed on the F lorry.

Officers of the rank of Col will probably be accommodated at the Grand, will mark their kit with G and it will be carried on lorry G.

In addition all officers will ensure that their name is clearly displayed on the luggage and labels.

9 Deliveries:

If possible, personal baggage on lorries D F G will be offloaded on arrival at quarters in which case officers will take delivery of their kit. If this is not possible the baggage officer will be responsible for safe custody during the night and for arranging delivery next morning.

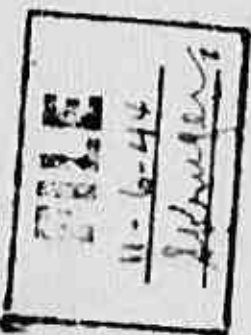

1. It is intended that Main HQ AAI shall move to the ROME area as soon as possible after 25 Jun. Those branches and services which are concerned with shipping and rlyc will move later. The move of the whole HQ incl shipping and rly branches to the ROME area will be completed not later than 7 July 44.
2. Adv HQ AAI will join the Main HQ AAI in the ROME area unless a further move fwd of Adv HQ has become necessary.

(ii) Start Time: Convoy A, 0005 hours
Convoy B, 0100 hours
- e. Route: Route 7 - See Appendix "B".
- f. Halts: 10 minutes halt at 10 minutes to every second hour.
One hours halt after each 5 hours.
Vehicles will not close up at halts, and will pull well into the side of the road.
Convoy Group Commanders will check vehicles and personnel at each halt.
