Attn: Major Head

1. On Sunday 30 April 1944, a package was brought to this office by EMIO BARTOLINI, employee of the Italian Ministry of Agriculture, who asked us to send it via the ACC Courier to Lt (USCOR) Mulieri, Agriculture Sub-Commission Naples, through a Mario SANTONELLI, a civilian employee of Lt Mulieri's office. Bearing no censor stamp or signature and upon admission by Bartolini that the contents were personal, the package was opened here and found to contain cheese. The cheese was held here in this office and Capt Turner notified since the matter involved violation or attempts at violation of postal regulations:

- a. Censorship
- b. Civilian attempting to communicate with member of Allied Forces.
- c. Attempting to use official mail to avoid payment of postage.

2. Capt Turner instructed us on 1 May to return the cheese to Bartolini, and to retain the wrapper and letter and submit together with a written report.

3. Passed to you for any action you deem necessary.
