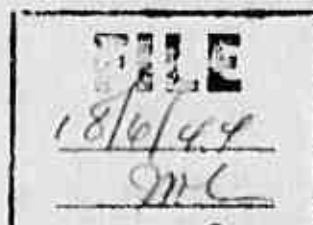

1. Confirming telephone conversation to you today, this Hq feels the most satisfactory times for courier service are the following:

2. The departure times of couriers from Salerno are those which have been in operation for some days. The schedule as projected in paragraph 1 of this indorsement would not involve putting on more transportation,

3. It is important that the last courier from Naples each evening leave not later than 1500 hours in order that mail may be delivered in Salerno the same evening. This Hq has changed the office hours for all personnel so that offices operate until 1745 hours each day. In order to handle mail received on the 1500 hours courier from Naples, a delay in departure of 1 hour at the main Hq would mean that all mail brought here would be handled the following day.
