TO : Commanding General, North African Theater of Operations, U. S. Army, c/o Postmaster, New York, New York.

1. Government Agencies in the United States have contacted the War Department for information concerning alphabetical abbreviations used in communications and other official documents emanating from overseas theaters. In the majority of these instances it has been found that these abbreviations were not authorized by Army Regulation.

2. To avoid unnecessary delays which inevitably follow, it is requested that in communications issued by United States forces or by combined United States and British forces, the words, for which no abbreviation is authorized by FM 21-30 and AR 850-150, be spelled out in full the first time they appear in each and every communication, followed by the abbreviation in parentheses.
