1. Announcement is made of the opening and closing dates for future General Staff Classes at the Command and General Staff School, Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, as follows:

2. Available to this headquarters is the allotment of one officer to the Command Staff course and one officer to the Service Staff Course for each class. Officers detailed to attend the General Staff Class must not be below the rank of 1st Lieutenant and must be qualified in tactics and techniques of basic arm or equivalent experience gained from troop duty. Though college education is not a specific requirement, it is felt to be highly desirable and should be considered in making selections. No age limit is placed on the Service Course, although care should be exercised in making selection of officers over forty (40) years of age.

3. It is desired that recommendations for officers to attend these classes be submitted so as to reach this headquarters forty-five (45) days
