1. It is desired that this Headquarters be notified of any officers or enlisted men of your organization desiring to apply for duty with Paratroops. Personnel selected for this training will be attached to an airborne training unit. Those failing to complete the course prescribed will be returned to personnel centers as general assignment personnel. The requirements for such training are as follows:
