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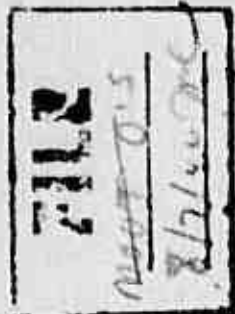

1 INTENTION.

The Sub-Commissions located at SALERNO will move by road to ROME on 9 Jul 44.

2 DETAIL

Offices of these Sub-Commissions will close at SALERNO at 1600 hours 8 Jul 44 and re-open at the same time at ROME.

a Transport: 8 - 3 ten lorries and 1 Staff Car will be provided by HQ Comdt fully fuelled and ciled with reserve equal to tank capacity at the Palace of Justice at 0700 hours 9 Jul 44.

b Convoy Comdr: Lt Col S. H. WHITE.

c Assembly Point & Time: Hotel Vittoria, Cava. 0820 hrs.

d Starting Point & Time: Road junction M5935 (N of Cava) 0840 hrs.

e Route: To Naples, Route 18 thereafter Route 7.

f Speed and Density: 15 MPH 20 VPM, after 2100 hrs 40 VPM.

g Halts: For 1 hour at 1300 and 1900 hours:

for 15 min at 0915, 1100, 1500, 1700, 2100 hrs.

h Rations & Water: Haversack rations (one day will be carried). A hot meal will be provided on arrival. Water bottles will be full, a refill can be obtained at a water point M 7894 (about 1500 hrs). Under no circumstances will water from unauthorised sources be used for any purpose.

i Dress: American: Full field kit khaki clothing.

British: FSAM, Slacks, Helmets on packs.

j Discipline: Convoy Duty Officer: 2/Lt P. S. HUSBAND, will travel in leadin car and will be responsible for checking that cars are fully fuelled when received, despatching same to loading points, marshalling at assembly and starting points, for route, pace, halting, starting and checking vehicle and personnel strength at halts, seeing that road is clear at halts and road sentries are posted. Emergency refuelling point M5998 W of ITRI (about 1530 hrs). Leading and rear cars of convoy will carry blue and green flags respectively. Breakdowns will be reported. The convoy will keep well in the right hand side of the road.

k Mines:

In many districts only a narrow margin on each side of the road has been swept, in some areas personnel mines which have been located have been marked (stick and a bunch of grass) but not removed. At halts, all ranks will regard notices as to marks and avoid inter-

No furniture or fittings will be taken.

Sub-Commissions will prepare a list of their packages and their senior NCO will check that they are all loaded and hand a copy of the list to the transport officer who will obtain a receipt on his copy on giving delivery of the stores in Rome. He will remain responsible for the stores overnight and will satisfy himself as to their safe custody until delivery.

8 Officers and Officers baggage.

Officers are responsible for seeing that their baggage is stacked in the appropriate place at either the Palace of Justice by 0630 hrs or the Hotel Vittoria by 0730 hrs.

Officers living in Salerno will take their places in Lorry B before 0730 hrs. Those living at Casa will take the places allotted to them before 0830 hrs.

Officers are advised to take with them in their cars a haversack or small handbag with kit for the night, in case their kit is not delivered the same night (The convoy is not due to arrive until about 2000 hrs).

Officers up to rank of Lt Col will probably be located at the Flora, will mark their kit conspicuously and it will be packed on the F lorry.

Officers of the rank of Col will probably be accommodated at the Grand, will mark their kit with G and it will be carried on lorry G.

In addition all officers will ensure that their name is clearly displayed on the luggage and labels.

9 Deliveries:

If possible, personal baggage on lorries D F G will be offloaded on arrival at quarters in which case officers will take delivery of their kit. If this is not possible the baggage officer will be responsible for safe custody during the night and for arranging delivery next morning.

Subject: Move of Headquarters, ACC, Rear Party From Palermo

To : Headquarters Commandant
Allied Control Commission
Salerno

1. The First Echelon of Headquarters, ACC, Rear Party, departed Palermo 31 January at 0700 hours by Motor Convoy No. 013101-3 with thirty one motor vehicles, including two motorcycles, and personnel consisting of six (6) officers and fifty eight (58) enlisted men or other ranks. The vehicles in this convoy consist of the following:

- 10 - Trucks, 1/4 ton
- 5 - Staff Cars
- 2 - Trucks, 3 ton
- 12 - Trucks, 15 cwt.
- 2 - Motorcycles

2. This convoy should arrive Salerno on 3 or 4 February and the Convoy Commander will report to your office for further instructions.

3. All officers, enlisted men and other ranks, of the above personnel in this convoy will proceed on to Naples, with the exception of Private R. C. Jones, British, who is assigned to the Public Safety Sub-Commission and who should be retained in Salerno.

4. All motor vehicles, office furniture, office equipment and other equipment in the convoy will be dispatched to Naples, where the proper distribution will be made. In this connection, the ratio of distribution of available motor vehicles between Salerno and Naples Headquarters is now being calculated and the actual distribution of additional vehicles to Salerno will be made immediately after the arrival of the Palermo convoy in Naples.

5. The Second Echelon of Headquarters, ACC, Rear Party, consisting of eight (8) officers, eighty nine (89) enlisted men or other ranks, motor vehicles, equipment and freight will move from Palermo by sea. The date of departure of this party is not yet known, due to the uncertain shipping accommodations. You will be advised of the dates of departure and arrival upon receipt of information in this office.

6. The date of the movement of the third and last Echelon of Headquarters, AGO, Bear Party, consisting of three (3) officers, four (4) enlisted men or other ranks and three vehicles, remaining in Salerno to clear records, will be announced at a later date upon receipt of information.

7. You will prepare to house the personnel and equipment of this convoy overnight in case the time of arrival at Salerno will not permit proceeding on to Naples. You will advise this office by telephone upon arrival of this convoy and instructions will be issued as to when convoy should depart Salerno.

8. Reference paragraphs 1 and 3 above. A separate communication is being issued giving details as to personnel.
