SUBJECT: Elimination of Unnecessary Correspondence.

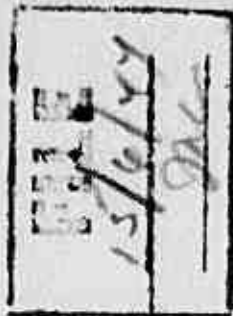

TO : Regional Commissioners of Regions I, II, III, IV, V, VI,
S.C.A.C.s 5th Army, 8th Army; Directors of Sub-Commissions,
and Chiefs of Staff Sections.
