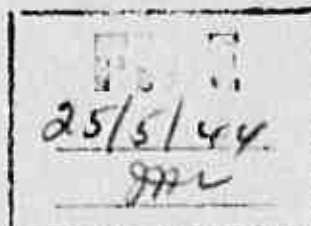

SUBJECT: Civilian Food Handlers.

TO : All Units, this Regiment.



24 May 1944

1. The following information is brought to the attention of all unit commanders, this Regiment, and in particular to all mess officers. A report from the Regimental Surgeon indicates that the large turnover of civilian employees is the result of:

a. Civilians being employed without proper certificate as to the absence of infectious diseases.

b. New employees found to be unfit after examination and are a source of infection during this interval.

2. It is directed that all civilians employed by this Regiment be examined and certified by the Regimental Surgeon, or, in his absence, by a qualified medical officer, before they are permitted to serve as food handlers.
