Those arrested in Sicily and Island of Ustica. Move to Sicily to camps under control distance for early review of cases by local review board.

Those arrested in pantellaria and Lampedusa. Procedure as in para two considered impracticable. Therefore propose nominal roll and available details be sent SCAG Pantellaria for investigation and comment. Review Board to be set up in North Africa who would decide for release or continued detention on available evidence and fresh details provided by SCAG. Those released to be sent to islands. Those detained to remain North Africa.

Please state concurrence or comments proposal as in para three one and indicate whether SCAG or other AMB officer could be made available from Pantellaria to attend review board in North Africa if required.

Held in North Africa under control AMB are one six five civilians.

Meantime have urged earliest approval and proposed simultaneous Announcements from AFM and ACC. CCS may decide that simultaneous Announcements should also be made from London, Moscow and Washington which would cause slight delay.

No objection to your announcing details op(?) ACC when transfer of territory is announced.

Text transmitted to CCS for approval differs from your text in following points and changes in your text should be made accordingly. Paragraph 2. Read "have" for "enjoy" in line 5. Paragraph 2. Last sentence should read: "where Allied Military Government has been operating within the territory thus restored, it will accordingly be brought to an end." Paragraph 3. Third sentence should read: "It was a human necessity that the men, women and children in the occupied territory should be relieved as far as possible from the distress which military operations had brought upon them." Paragraph 7. Second sentence should read: "The principal duty assigned to it was to take such measures of control according to the terms of the Armistice as to transform Italy into an effective instrument of war against Germany." Greek Government has approached British and USA Governments with view to arranging movement Greek nationals in Italy being Ex POW or displaced persons shall be transferred to Mideast. Same policy to be followed as remainder Italy liberated. Present policy is to evacuate only Ex POW and male displaced persons of military age and capable military service except from this special sanction as given in your cable quoted above. Not anticipated number all category will be heavy in future and partly accepted by you in cable quoted clears all those held at present. All persons for evacuation would be screened by G-2 and Greek representatives attached Displaced Persons Sub-Commission before movement. In view approach by Greek Government to British and USA Governments suggest you agree accept policy proposed.

1. G-2 Summary. (i) No special summary since 7 February. (ii) 8th Army. No enemy activity reported. (iii) 5th Army. Active enemy patrolling sector (N0140) - SMT? S Croce (09333). Heavy enemy shelling sector northeast Monte Cairo. Communications difficult this area owing snow. Heavy fighting continues in northern districts. Cassino. Enemy using tanks and flame-throwers. Heavy Nebelwerfer and mortar fire.
2. Small arms fire on lesser scale. South of Cassino enemy has again patrolled east of Rapido to secure identifications. In lower Carigliano sector enemy continues stubborn resistance area Monte Faito (08503) and has counterattacked unsuccessfully on Monte Ornit (08602). Enemy reinforcements reported arriving this area. No indication identity of this but suggest possibly from bridgehead area as enemy hardly able to withdraw forces from any other sector of main.
3. Front 4. 71 Corps. On morning 9 February enemy made strong attack estimated strength 1 division plus 2 brigades in the general direction of road Albani-Anzio principally against area Aprilia-Carrocceto. No details available. Allied counter attacks made during afternoon and latest reports state situation difficult but showing some signs improvement. Allies still generally along 32 Grid line. Estimate the build-up now equivalent rather over 6 divisions with probably 130 tanks.
4. Including evidently some heavies according recent statements of armoured reinforcements moving through Rome. Latter variously reported to be from France and

Herewith reply to your Memorandum of the 5th February Reference CG/6/33 covering a written communication from the Italian Government putting forward 3 requests concerning the control of criticism of the government and the activities of officials of the psychological warfare branch in Italy. On the 1st point you may say that it is the Allied policy that there be free expression of opinion in liberated Italy, subject to the requirements of security and public order. On the second point you may say that such facilities as may be available for the publication of newspapers will be distributed impartially among all sections of opinion. To the 3rd request you may reply that the policy is that Allied officers in Italy concerned with matters of censorship, information or propaganda will act on basis of strict impartiality and without bias towards any section of Italian public opinion. At its next meeting the Advisory Council for Italy will be informed on my behalf of the Italian representations and of my reply.

Sitrep No. 157. 8th Army. Nothing to report. 5th Army. On 2nd Corps front elements of 34th Division continued to maintain pressure in Cassino town. Heavy fighting was in progress on New Zealand Corps front. Heavy enemy counterattacks were made against positions of 4th Indian Division on hills just northwest of M Cassino but late reports indicate these features are still in our hands. 2nd NZ Division bridgehead south of Cassino was likewise counterattacked and our troops were forced to the east bank of Rapido. However covering forces remain on west bank to protect bridge. On 10th Corps front 2 enemy attacks against elements of one Guardia Bde in the area 2 miles north of Castelforte were repulsed. On 6th Corps front the enemy continued this attack on 45th Division of 18th February employing some 20 battalions.
