1. On about 19 Dec 43 I made an inspection and inventory of the Villa Ferrera, at your request. A requisition signed by claims and fittings was also served on the care taker of the Villa requesting occupation by AGM on 24 Dec 43.

2. At the time of the inspection and inventory, the Villa was occupied by a renter, Prof. Alfonso Lopez, who also had in the Villa adequate furniture of his own, plus a small amount belonging to the owner of the Villa, to make it presentable and comfortable for occupancy by the AGM.

3. Since the professor was moving to Iquique and needed certain furniture for a room or two in that city, some items of his in the inventory were checked as belonging to him. It was also indicated that he might take these few items with him; they being only a small portion of the furniture then in the Villa--his and the owner's. The professor was also warned at that time that the remainder of his furniture and that of the owner must remain in the Villa until further notice. A sign was also placed on the door indicating occupancy by AGM and forbidding the removal of any furniture.

4. On inspecting the Villa on 28 Dec 43, I found that all the furniture belonging to the professor had been removed. The remains; only a few chairs and several beds, are not at all sufficient to make the Villa suitable for living quarters.

5. The original hand-written copy of the inventory is attached to our file copy. Check marks on the hand-written

Memorandum to Brigadier Gueterbock

1. Confirming the information I gave you 12 December in Naples, General Joyce will occupy the Villa Guariglia at Raito near Vietri.

2. General Joyce wishes the following instructions given the detail making arrangements at Salerno:

A. Last 3/4 mile of road to Guariglia to be cleared of stones which have fallen down into roadway. ✓

B. Rugs to be obtained for living room and bedrooms at Guariglia.

C. Military police plans to include allotment for a guard at Guariglia day and night; also carabinieri to be stationed with this guard (Military guard to be smartly and distinctively uniformed within the limits of equipment available.). ✓

D. Electricity to be available in Villa before date of move. ✓

E. Villa to be equipped with telephone through arrangement with 94 Sub Area. ✓

F. Test to be made of Villa water supply.

G. Small advanced detachment to put Villa in order for General will arrive from Brindisi several days before ETA of General Joyce.
