SUBJECT: Entry into City of ROME.

TO : Distribution below.

1. 750/2/CA of 5 June 1944 is cancelled.
2. Members of the A.C.C. may now proceed to Rome without passes provided they have obtained permission from the Head of their Section or Independent Sub-Commission.
3. That part of 751/7/CA of 7 June 1944 relating to Italian officials is cancelled. Members of the Italian Government now have permanent passes. Italian officials may be granted passes to travel to Rome by the Secretary General at Naples or Salerno, without reference to the Security Branch, provided assent is given by the Head of the relevant Section or Independent Sub-Commission.

SCAO's 5th and 6th Armies.

1. Further to our 316/133/CA of 9 June 1944, the location of the Rear Army Security Control Line is now :

Road PESCARA POPOLI BAIANO CASTELVECCHIO AVEZZANO
ARSOLI TIVOLI thence along Northern boundary of
ROME AREA COMMAND to coast.

2. Control to be exercised by Army or Corps or District or Base Section through which line passes. When line follows boundary between Commands control to be exercised by northern-most Command.
