1. This office is forwarding the attached report made by the Hq. Commandant of the ACC, Rear Hq., against the Guards, Chiappetta and Chierozzo.
2. We stress the seriousness of the Guard's failure to do their duty, a seriousness rendered greater by the fact that they were in service for the Allies who make these occasions ^{a basis} for unpleasant estimates of Italians in general and, ~~in~~ in this specific ^{case, of our} Police Force, ~~in particular~~. Hence we wish to ask you to impose severe disciplinary penalties on the two guilty Guards, excluding them henceforth from this service, and to warn the Guards who will continue such service, and stress to them its political as well as its civic importance and the necessity of carrying it out with dignity and conscientiously.



It is pointed out that this Office was supposed to be transferred to Naples, and on this purpose an authorization had been given by Maj. Field of the AFHQ.

After 10 days this authorization has been withdrawn, and, in consequence, this office has been compelled to transfer itself to Cava dei Tirreni. Due to the effect that in Cava dei Tirreni are installed already the Presidency of the Council and the Comando Supremo, as well as other Authorities, the S.I.M. has faced the difficulties of billeting HQ Officers and Personnel.

The premises are those left behind the other Authorities because badly damaged, consequently, the request for the glasses is strictly true and indispensable to make the premises suitable for Offices and quarters.

It is therefore requested that the full amount of 350 sq.mts would be allotted as soon as possible.



1. Attached are three copies of authority from AFHQ Adv. Adm. Ech. for the issue of rations to Italian Government Officials. Lt. Col. Hindley Smith would have handled the arrangements had he not gone to the hospital. Pending his recovery or the appointment of a substitute Liaison Officer you will handle contacts between the 94th Sub-Area and the Italian Government.

2. The basis of rations as agreed with Col. ~~Ballatta~~ *Ballatta* was actually commissioned officers, civilians of officer rank and the lower grades all to be in military uniform. This is a very indefinite description of those entitled to rations and the actual number will have to be by agreement with a responsible Italian Official.

Merchant Marine Ministry accommodation proposed in MELBO letter to you dated 20 December conforms to my proposals agreed with Pettorelli Lalatta. As matter of principle General Robertson is averse to Italian Government offices in Naples but Raimondo Railways is already here and presumably Barone Shipping would be allowed here on MELBO invitation. Accommodation in Naples would be more easily obtained by MELBO than by us. Therefore I am having matter to MELBO to arrange subject your concurrence with MELBO proposal.

BRINDISI.

1. In the handling of day to day problems of controlling Italian Merchant Shipping it has become apparent to my Board that a much closer contact must be maintained with the Under Secretary for the Italian Merchant Marine.
2. At the present time problems are arising which necessitate meetings with Admiral Barone to determine such matters as Charter Party terms, rate of hire for vessels requisitioned by the Royal Italian Government and placed at the disposal of the Allied Commander in Chief. Experience has shown that such meetings (if they were held) could only be arranged at the expense of other essential duties.
3. I am informed by Commodore Palmer R.N. that it is intended that the office of the Under Secretary for the Italian Merchant Marine will be established at Salerno as from the approximate date of 1st January 1944.
4. It is submitted that Admiral Barone would be more conveniently sited in Naples in close touch with his Deep Sea Committee and the Coastwise Committee which have been formed to supervise the administration of Italian shipping. This is considered by F.O.W.I.F., FLAMBO, A.M.G., W.S.A., AND M.W.T. as being essential to the efficient control of all Italian ships.
5. I understand that Admiral Barone is perfectly willing to come to Naples, and that the main difficulty will be the question of office accommodation and living quarters for his staff.
