- 1. In the handling of day to day problems of controlling Italian Merchant Shipping it has become apparent to my Board that a much closer contact must be maintained with the Under Secretary for the Italian Merchant Marine.
- 2. At the present time problems are arising which necessitate meetings with Admiral Barone to determine such matters as Charter Party terms, rate of hire for vessels requisitioned by the Royal Italian Government and placed at the disposal of the Allied Commander in Chief. Experience has shown that such meetings (if they were held) could only be arranged at the expense of other essential duties.
- 3. I am informed by Commodore Palmer R.N. that it is intended that the office of the Under Secretary for the Italian Merchant Marine will be established at Salerno as from the approximate date of 1st January 1944.
- 4. It is submitted that Admiral Barone would be more conveniently sited in Naples in close touch with his Deep Sea Committee and the Coastwise Committee which have been formed to supervise the administration of Italian shipping. This is considered by F.O.W.I.T., FLAMBO, A.M.G., M.S.A., AND M.W.T. as being essential to the efficient control of all Italian ships.

5. I understand that Admiral Barone is perfectly willing to come to Naples, and that the main difficulty will be the question of office accommodation and living quarters for his staff.
