1. C. C. Vintage will be on duty at the information desk at least one hour before the start of the parties. He will instruct an officer to ensure all officers billeted at the Williams, Navy House, or via independent to 5, to their respective quarters. (see attached).
2. Major Harvey will be on duty at the information desk at least one hour before the start of the parties. He will ensure that all officers to be billeted in the dining of the Victoria Hotel, have available means of transport for a return and their bills.
3. The Transport or assistant will be on duty at least one hour before the start of the parties. He will be responsible for reception of transport, and parking all vehicles, and ensure available means of transport for a return and their bills.
4. The Major will be on duty at least one hour before the start of the parties. He will be responsible under the instructions of the Major and Capt. Sinclair for ensuring all allocations, and to their quarters, and ensuring administrative arrangements to them. He will also place on duty any or he then needs to help the smooth running of these parties.
5. Capt. Treg and Lt. (M) Sinclair will hold themselves entirely at the disposal of the Commandant.
6. Lt. (M) Sinclair will arrange for a meal to be served as soon as possible after the arrival of the parties.
7. Messing Officer, Williams' mess, will also ensure any arrangements for or leave first meals after arrival.
8. Messing must be observed as far as possible.
9. The Lt. Major will appoint N. or under and it's own room. He will be responsible for supervision of blankets, cleanliness, and discipline.
10. C. C. Harvey will be asked to report to the Commandant, by Capt. Treg.
