SUBJECT: Lt. Vincenzo Frascolla (Italian Army)

TO : Liaison Section

Around the 1st of April 1944 Lt. Vincenzo Frascolla (I) was sent on orders from this office to Bari, Lecce and Taranto to procure 5 requisitioned Italian automobiles for the Allied Control Commission. He was instructed to notify this office in 5 days for the aid that was necessary to bring the cars to Salerno. This he did not do, and on the 14th of April he was located at Taranto. This office then sent another Italian officer and four soldiers, (three American and one Italian) to bring these cars to Salerno and to deliver a copy of the enclosed Written Order for Lt. Frascolla to return to this station. The Order was delivered on or about the 16th of April. This Order has not been obeyed nor have we heard from Lt. Frascolla. This can not be tolerated by this office.

Therefore we must ask that Lt. Frascolla be relieved from his duties here.

This office needs the services of an Italian Officer to take care of the discipline of the Italian soldier and the necessary administration work. We would prefer a good officer who is not an automobilist.

At about 19.40 hrs 13 Mar. 44 I was walking down the main street SALERNO with Capt. A.S. PENNOYER and Major P.K. BAILLIE-REYNOLDS, from the Acc officers' mess towards the Odessa Cinema. We turned to cross the street, but paused to let a 3-ton lorry travelling in the same direction as ourselves pass. It was travelling about 20 mph and had, I believe, a single headlight. Captain PENNOYER undoubtedly saw the lorry, as he paused, and then moved as if to pass behind it, but was struck apparently by some projection from the body of the lorry and fell unconscious in the road. The lorry did not stop; I very much doubt if the driver knew he had hit anything, for the lorry was struck by some part of the truck behind the cab. Major REYNOLDS got Capt. PENNOYER onto the pavement and applied a field-dressing, while I ran for medical assistance. With the aid of some American officers and a Jeep, Capt. PENNOYER was got to the central M.T. room, SALERNO, and was removed thence by ambulance to 58 Gen. Hospital where he arrived at 21.10 hrs. Capt. BRAGE, M.C. Commandant, Acc, accompanied us to the hospital.

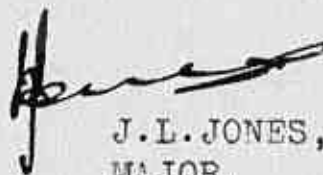

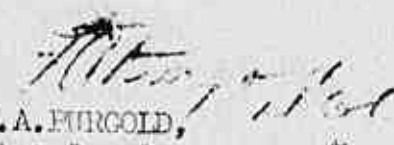
