SECURITY PLAN FOR PALERMO AREA

REF. MAP - TOWN PLAN OF PALERMO.

1. MISSION. The purpose of this plan is to provide protection to military personnel, equipment and supplies in the event of an emergency, such as an amphibian landing, attack by parachutists and civil disorders.

2. RESPONSIBILITY. No. 1 District is responsible for the ground defense and general security of the whole of Sicily, including the Island Base Section Area. In the event of civil disorders, it is the responsibility of the Carabinieri to maintain law and order. If they are unable to deal with the situation, then the military may be called to restore control. Troops will be withdrawn when the civil administration has regained control.

3. CONTROL. The Commanding Officer, Island Base Section, will command all troops, including the 119th Infantry Brigade, 46th Infantry Regiment of the Sabauda Division and all American Troops, except those used to guard Seventh Army Headquarters Installations.

4. COMMUNICATIONS. In the event of an alert or warning order, each unit included in the plan will immediately send a messenger mounted in a jeep or on a motorcycle to their respective assembly area. The following units will send a liaison officer and a messenger to Headquarters, Island Base Section (Map Ref. B 439-467) upon an alert or warning order. The commanding officers of the units listed below will command all troops assembling in their respective areas and all unit messengers will report to them.

1. The attached price list has been compiled by the Civilian Supply Division to accompany General Order No. 4 for the guidance of Civil Affairs Officers.
2. The prices listed are the maximum which may be charged within the above areas. Offenders (both vendors and purchaser) should be promptly brought to justice.
3. It is impossible to set uniform prices for all provinces and, therefore, C.A.O.s may make revisions downward taking into consideration all local circumstances.
4. The prices quoted are all consumer prices and the maximum wholesale prices are only 85% of the retail prices. Maximum prices which producers may charge when selling to wholesalers are but 75% of those listed. If the military forces buy from retailers, they should pay retail prices; when buying from wholesalers, wholesale prices; and when buying from producers, producer prices.
5. If the following maximum prices occasion undue hardship, the question of possible revision should be taken up with the Civilian Supply Division, A.M.C.O.T. H.Q.
6. This list is for your information and is not for publication or communication to Italian officials.

PROPOSED PROCEDURE FOR PROCUREMENT OF CIVIL SUPPLIES

1. Requisitioning supplies for civilian population.

a. AMGOT Hq, 15 Army Group, will be responsible for requisitioning all civil supplies for all Italy, including Sicily, for both short term (first 90 days) and long term (subsequent 6 months).

b. Requisitions will be submitted direct from AMGOT Hq to AFHQ with information copies to 15 Army Group.

c. M.G.S., AFHQ, will be responsible for forwarding requisitions to appropriate supply agencies and progressing procurement of supplies.

2. Bidding Supplies Forward.

a. AMGOT Hq, 15 Army Group will be responsible for bidding all supplies forward for all Italy, excluding Sicily. Supplies for Sicily will be bid forward by Anget, Palermo, either direct to AFHQ or through No. 1 District.

b. Bids will be made direct to Major General Robertson's Hq.

c. M.G.S., AFHQ, will be responsible for arranging and progressing loadings through appropriate supply services.

3. Unloading, Transport, Warehousing and Distribution.

a. AMGOT will be responsible for receiving, transporting, warehousing and distribution of all civil supplies imported into Italy, including Sicily.

b. In ports where civil supplies usually arrive spread loaded with military supplies, appropriate Base Section or Area will unload and transport civil supplies to AMGOT warehouses. AMGOT will warehouse and distribute.

c. In non-military ports where civil supplies will arrive on exclusively AMGOT tonnage, AMGOT arrange unloading, transport, warehousing and distribution, either directly in regions under AMGOT administration, or with cooperation of Allied Military Mission and Italian Government in regions under their administration.

4. Demands for shipping for AMGOT regions in Military District No. 2 and in 5th and 8th Army areas for 10 day periods, 30 days ahead, will be submitted to AMGOT, 15 Army Group, consolidated there, and sent to Major General Robertson's Hq for calling forward. AMGOT, 15 Army Group will send a copy of their consolidated demands for calls forward, together with detailed breakdowns of the tonnage obtained to M.G.S., AFHQ for action and AMGOT, Palermo for information.
