15. Use of W.D. Transport for Recreational Purposes

Regional Commissioners and HQ Commandants (Main and Rear) are authorized to sanction the use of W.D. Transport for recreational purposes subject to the limitations imposed by G.E.O. 256 of 4 June 43, which is republished below.

(G-4700/12).

G.E.O. 256 of 4 June 1943

1. W.D. Transport may be used for recreational purposes subject to the provisions of this Order.
2. Formation Commanders may authorize Officers commanding units within their formations to sanction the use of W.D. transport for recreational purposes subject to the following limitations:-
 - (a) W.D. vehicles will not be used where rail transport is available.
 - (b) No officer or soldier will be allowed more than one journey per week.
 - (c) G.O.s. will be responsible that the type of vehicle employed does not exceed the capacity required, and they will not authorize the use of motor cars by other ranks unless they are satisfied that it is unaccommmodial to use a larger vehicle.
 - (d) Motor Cycles will not be used.
 - (e) Journeys over 20 miles from quarters will not be permitted.

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Regional Commissioners and R. Commandants (Main and Rear) are authorized to sanction the use of W.D. Transport for recreational purposes subject to the limitations imposed by G.R.O. 250 of 4 Jan 43, which is republished below.

(G.R.O. 250/12).

G.R.O. 256 of 4 June 1943

1. W.D. Transport may be used for recreational purposes subject to the provisions of this Order.
2. Formation Commanders may authorize Officers attending units within their formations to sanction the use of W.D. transport for recreational purposes subject to the following limitations:-
 - (a) W.D. vehicles will not be used where rail transport is available.
 - (b) No officer or soldier will be allowed more than one journey per week.
 - (c) C.Os. will be responsible that the type of vehicle employed does not exceed the capacity required, and they will not authorize the use of motor cars by other ranks unless they are satisfied that it is unreasonable to use a larger vehicle.
 - (d) Motor Cycles will not be used.
 - (e) Journeys over 20 miles from quarters will not be permitted except on the authority of the Rde. or equivalent commanders.
 - (f) Where in the opinion of the formation commander it is desirable to exercise greater supervision, e.g. in the case of small units formation commanders may direct that such units obtain the prior sanction of formation HQ before using the unit transport for recreational purposes.

3. This concession does not relieve formation and unit commanders of the responsibility for the conservation of petrol and rubber.

4. Work tickets will invariably be used.

5. Charges :-

Officers.....	2 Hire per mile
Officers accompanying other ranks on recreational journeys.....	1 Hire per mile
C...Other Ranks.....	

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Other Banks and facilities..... Five per mile.
subject to maximum charge for other ranks of 10 Lira for each
return journey.

6. Collection of Charges.

(a) Personnel conveyed in own Unit W.D. Transport.

O.C. will be responsible for collection of the amounts due to the public and will take on such amounts as receipts in their Imprest Account.

The entry in the Imprest Account will be supported by a statement or voucher showing (i) the total number of miles travelled (ii) the number of officers and/or other ranks conveyed (iii) the amount due to the public.

Statements or vouchers will be serially numbered and bear a reference as follows - (Unit) / W.D.T.R. / (Serial No.) - and will be certified correct by the O.C.

(b) Personnel conveyed in W.D. Transport of another Unit.

The O.C. supplying the W.D. Transport will prepare a certified Statement (or voucher) in quadruplicate as in (a) above, immediately the services have been completed. The Statement (or voucher) will also be endorsed to show the unit to which the transport was supplied. One copy of the Statement will be sent to the Command Paymaster, No. 2 Command Pay Office and two copies to the O.C. unit to which the W.D. transport was supplied. The fourth copy will be retained until notification is received from Command Paymaster that payment has been made and brought to account.

The O.C. unit to which the W.D. Transport was supplied will pay in the amount due to the nearest Field Cashier, supported by the two copies of the Statement or voucher, one copy of which will be returned to him receipted by the Cashier.

One copy of the Statement will be sent to the Command Paymaster, No. 2 Command Pay Office and two copies to the O.C. Unit to which the W.D. transport was supplied. The fourth copy will be retained until notification is received from Command Paymaster that payment has been made and brought to account.

The O.C. Unit to which the W.D. Transport was supplied will pay in the amount due to the nearest Field Cashier, supported by the two copies of the Statement or voucher, one copy of which will be returned to him receipted by the Cashier.

19. Priod Parts Lists - W.D. Vehicles

Application has been made to Q (AE) HQ A.A.I. for priod parts lists in respect of W.D. Vehicles.

It is notified that all such applications are dealt with by A.D.O.S. (P), A.A.I. w/o D.D.D.S. I of C (Depots) to whom exact details of requirements should be submitted. It will be found however that the standard Parts Lists as stocked for W.D. use, is very seldom priod, and a full range of priod W.D. vehicle parts list does not even exist in U.K.

20. Visits

Owing to the present pressure of operational work at Headquarters, Fifth Army, Eighth Army and 5 Corps, it is necessary to control drastically the number of officers visiting these HQs and formations under their command. All Regions, Sections, Divisions and Sub-Divisions will, therefore, ensure that no officer goes forward to visit unless his business cannot be transacted in any other way or on a special invitation of the branch of the Headquarters concerned.

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Any Region, Section, Branch or Sub-Commission wishing to arrange visits for officers to any of the above Headquarters will submit their application and the reason for the visit to this HQ for approval.

21. Recovery "B" Vehicles.

A.A.2, Routine Order 63 of 14 April 44 is repeated for the information and pleasure of all concerned.

(a) In order to improve the method of reporting "B" Vehicle casualties requiring REE recovery assistance, drivers of all "B" Vehicles will carry copies of the proforma, as shown at Appendix "A" to this Order, in A.B.442.

(b) When a casualty occurs, the driver will complete the proforma and hand to the driver of a passing vehicle for delivery to the REE Recovery Post.

(c) This system will become effective from the date of this Order.
