2. I wish to explain, again, that this particular officer is unsuitable from our standpoint mainly on account of his youth, and lack of practical experience.

3. I should be glad if the Assignment Board, would, in the future, keep in mind the point that no Officer below the age of about 35 years is at all likely to have had the experience necessary to give efficient service with this Sub Commission.

4. I must request, therefore, that Lieut. Juditz be assigned to some other duty.

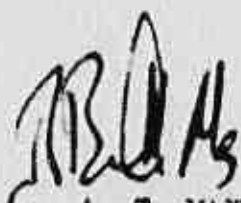
