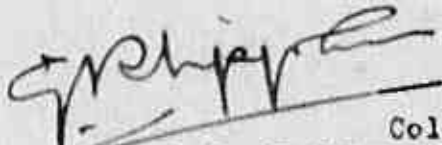

It is suggested that a reply should be sent to Lt. Col. Monagahan in reply to his letter of 2 Oct 43 on the following lines. His memorandum has been carefully considered by Brigadier Dooly, Col. Adams, Brigadier Parkinson of the Public Health Sub-Commission, and Col. Evans of Industry & Commerce. Brigadier Parkinson and Col. Evans expressed a hope that their Divisions would be able to keep their own accounts under the guidance of the Chief Accountant. It is realised that the plan outlined in Lt. Col. Tubb's memorandum involves a different procedure.

We are endeavouring to borrow five accounting officers in order that you may have them for say two months in your department to help in the present emergency. Two of these will be loaned to you for at least one month by the Finance Sub-Commission of the Allied Commission and efforts are being made by us to obtain another three from other sources. A suggestion has been made here that some of the accounting could be done by C.S.s. and we are endeavouring to get 20 C.S.s. for training in Tripoli. They would then be made available as bookkeepers and check record clerks. These clerks could then be distributed among the various departments requiring them.

Our Chief Accountant, Col. Greenham, is on his way to Palermo and it is hoped that he should be able to discuss the whole of this problem with you. Would you please show this letter to him on his arrival.

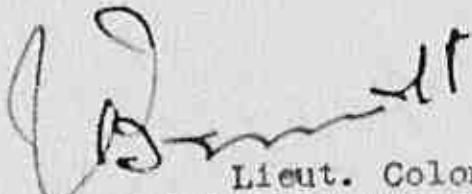

1. Colonel Rathbone called for the highest degree of efficiency for the near future. He informed the Chief Clerk that the alerted personnel will return to the original assignments and further changes are to be expected.
2. The Chief Clerk feels that he cannot guarantee the highest degree of efficiency if the supply situation (see attached AC/1006 of 6 Oct 43) and personnel situation is not substantially improved.
3. The Chief Clerk, C.R. does not run an employment agency. He is concerned with the provision of personnel for the C.R. and, if necessary, for other offices of National HQ. He has nothing to do with provision of personnel for Regions. Letters requesting personnel may be brought to the typing pool for execution, but the C.C. has not the authority (not to mention the time) to coordinate conflicting requests.
4. C.R. personnel has been subject to almost weekly changes. Only four of the original staff are left. Assignments, duty rosters have to be changed continuously. Almost all personnel including the Chief Clerk is assigned to TD only. Any activated unit can draw men from this office and with priority did and will do it in future.
5. Regions 3 and 6 offered definite TG/WE vacancies, functions connected with a certain rank. C.R. assignments are completely vague and may mean the loss of a clear chance elsewhere. It is not only the priority that is effective; rank is attractive to discontented temporary personnel.
6. At present 95 EM and ORs are on duty with the C.R. 95 men are outside the C.R. with National HQ. In addition an advance party of 75 had been alerted. Furthermore a number of men were posted to this HQ in the Warning Order of September 3 which was subsequently cancelled but never cancelled. Some of them are working, others not.

7. This morning the Chief Clerk was informed that the operation CAVALLER will not take place. At the same time he learned of Region 4 personnel needs. When inquiring about the situation he was told by Major Furgold that the recent alert order had been scrapped and the old suspended working order was to be considered as cancelled. That means that all HQ personnel is again unassigned, in the pool, and subject to call by any Region, particularly Region 4. 1. Upon his return from Algiers Major Hinkel informed me that a few typewriter ribbons were obtained by Mr. Ellenbast yesterday and are available for us here now. Considering the great need for new ribbons to keep the remaining machines going and also the possibility of putting the Woodstock typewriter, now out of use, in use again I request that Mr. Ellenbast be contacted immediately.
 2. The office is practically on the verge of breaking down due to the lack of supplies. In this connection I dare to say that we were always told by the Ho. Commandant that the shortage was due to non-arrival of indented ~~material~~ material; I was very much surprised, therefore when I learned from Major Sommerville that he had never been aware of our acute troubles.
 3. The fact is that this office needs not only typewriters and ribbons, but every possible kind of office equipment and stationary, especially file folders, clips, pencils. Supply 60 miles from the largest Base must be possible.

Prior to that we had been informed that only Gestetner machines were in the house and stencils for them could not be found. This created a bottleneck for weeks.
 5. There is need for an all day supply service. It must be possible to keep the store open from 0800 to 2000. Supplies are issued to the C.R. in small quantities which have to be requested each time on a chit and approved by your office. Last night f.i. duplicating had to stop at 1900hrs because no supplies could be obtained. A change is desirable.

6. Trouble with the keys goes on. Keys are misplaced, lost, people are locked out etc. Since a sign out book has not been approved other improvements are imperative. I discussed the matter last night with your Staff Sgt Gaister and we agreed on the advisability of the following changes : All keys have to be numbered. (Names such as Brig Carr Outer etc will have to be replaced by number. A new horizontal key board is to be used, wooden tags and keys only be issued by the information man who will make an inventory before going off duty.
7. I am sure that the difficulties listed in paras 1-6 are due to the frequent changes in organisation and personnel and that improvements are possible. However, the Chief Clerk cannot, or better must not, be bothered with matters that are delegated to other people i.e. keys and stationary. Likewise responsibility for the efficiency of this office cannot be accepted under the circumstances.

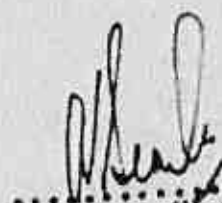
