PROPERTY CONTROL SUB-COMMISSION
OF ARMISTICE CONTROL COMMISSION

1. MISSION:

To initiate and develop policies and procedures for the acquisition, control, management, safekeeping, disposition, etc., of Allied and enemy property, and to establish and maintain records and accounts of same.

2. MAJOR FUNCTIONS:

The duties of the Controller of Allied and Enemy Property will be the following:

(a) He will take custody of:

1. All property in Italian territory belonging to any state against which any of the United Nations is at war and not already in custody of some branch of the Armed Forces. (This class of property includes corporations, companies, associations or institutions in which any such state has any substantial interest or over which it exercises substantial control).
2. Private property in Italian territory belonging to nationals of states, other than Italy, at war with any of the United Nations.
3. Property in Italian territory belonging to any of the United Nations, or nationals thereof, including that which has been sequestered by the Italian Government.

(b) He will also take into his custody, when directed to do so by the President or Deputy President of the Armistice Control Commission, or their authorized representatives, the following:

1. Property supplied or made available to the United Nations by the Italian Government.
2. Property belonging to Fascist Organizations.
3. Any property the control of which is, in the opinion of the President, or Deputy President of the Armistice Control Commission, or their authorized representatives, essential to the needs of the Allied Forces or the Armistice Control Commission.

(c) He will also:

1. Establish and maintain liaison with the appropriate agencies of the Italian Government in charge of enemy property and sequestered property.

2. Initiate orders to the Italian Government concerning the safeguarding and disposition of property of foreign states and nationals.
3. Require compliance with all orders issued to the Italian Government with respect to the safekeeping, management or disposition of property belonging to foreign states or nationals.
4. Assist all branches of the Allied Forces to ascertain, secure, and take possession of any enemy state property, as defined in 2(a) 1 above, and any enemy private property, as described in 2(a) 2 above, which is susceptible to military use and which may be required by the Allied Forces.
5. Initiate, establish, and maintain policies, procedures, and systems for recording the acquisition, management, control, disposition, etc. of properties taken into his custody.
