1. AMG Sicily have agreed to proposal that representatives from Special Divisions (normally the senior available) and Regions shall make short visits to Sicily to confer with their opposite numbers and see the practical working of AMG.
2. AMG stress that all such representatives must bring their own kit and bedding.
3. Please submit to G-1 by 1700 hrs Tuesday 14 Sept 1943 the names of officers whom it is desired to send. G-1 will submit list to Assistant Chiefs of Staff for approval. G-4 will arrange movement.
