1. It cannot yet be definitely stated what extra personnel will be required for SARDINIA. In the meantime no more assignments should be made. Arrangements have not yet been finalised for the move of the remainder of the advance party.
2. Personnel who are assigned to Region 6 in excess of the original 32 selected for the advance party may now be given other assignments. Should at a later date extra personnel be required, they will have to be withdrawn from other assignments.
3. It is not proposed to alter the ME for Region 6 at the moment.

REFERENCE: AC/1967/(S-1)

DATE: 13 October 1963.

1. The position of Region 6 requires clarification. It is at present as follows:-

(a) A TO/HS has been approved and a formation letter received. (U.L. RA/1963/1 dated 16 September 1963, under authority of A.F.H.Q. letter S-1 (B) 1963/180/21 dated 21 September 1963.) This TO/HS is based on the Paper No. 7 figures for Military Government - not Armistice Control. The British element is 45 Officers and 61 C.Ns., the proposed American element being 65 Officers and 100 E.Ns.

(b) An advance party of 53 Officers and 60 EN/ONS has been constituted.

(c) A reserve party of 8 Officers and 2 EN/ONS from the Advance Party referred to in (b) above is already in Sarabia under Brigadier Bealish.

(d) It is understood that the Advance Party will shortly join the reserve party in Sarabia.

2. The difference in numbers between the TO/HS referred to and the Advance Party (including the reserve party) is 50 Officers and 110 EN/ONS, and it is as regards this personnel that an early decision (which it is considered could and should be made without delay) is required. As a Planning Committee meeting next long ago, Colonel Hamall stated that assignments to Region 6 over and above the authorized Advance Party strength were still to be made, with due regard to priority. 14 such officers have been assigned.

3. (a) Will you therefore please give answers to the following questions:-

(1) Is it still the policy that Region 6 should be made up to full strength of the authorized TO/HS on the assumption that eventually the full numbers will be required in Sarabia?

(1A) If it is not to be so made up, on the assumption that the Advance Party will be sufficient for ultimate requirements, are the remaining personnel available for allotment elsewhere?

(b) If the answer to the latter question is in the affirmative, it is suggested that the TO/HS should not be amended, as it is well known that certain personnel entered for in Paper No. 7 will not be forth-coming, and the balance of personnel authorized for Region 6 could be used with advantage to fill some of such vacancies.

(c) A reserve party of 8 officers and 2 WU/MS from the Advance Party referred to in (b) above is already in Santiago under Brigadier Domínguez.

(d) It is understood that the Advance Party will shortly join the reserve party in Santiago.

8. The difference in numbers between the WU/MS referred to and the Advance Party (including the reserve party) is 80 officers and 110 WU/MS., and it is as regards this personnel that an early decision (which is to be considered could and should be made without delay) is required. At a Planning Committee Meeting not long ago, Colonel Hamell stated that assignments to Region 6 over and above the authorized Advance Party strength were still to be made, with due regard to priority. 14 such officers have been assigned.

9. (a) Will you therefore please give answers to the following questions:-

(1) Is it still the policy that Region 6 should be made up to full strength of the authorized WU/MS on the assumption that eventually the full numbers will be required in Santiago?

(11) If it is not to be so made up, on the assumption that the Advance Party will be sufficient for ultimate requirements, are the remaining personnel available for allocation elsewhere?

(12) If the answer to the latter question is in the affirmative, it is suggested that the WU/MS should not be omitted, as it is well known that certain personnel entered for in Paper No. 7 will not be forth-coming, and the balance of personnel committed for Region 6 could be used with advantage to fill gaps of real vacancies.

1. By memorandum dated 19 Sep., 1943. to C.C.A.O. Region VI, transmitted by indorsement of same date to Joint Assistant Chiefs of Staff, the inadequacy of the officer personnel, Legal Section Region VI was pointed out. The conclusions and recommendations of the memorandum were approved by the Acting Chief Legal Officer, National Headquarters and by the Chief Legal Officer, Amgot Headquarters as therein stated. In view of the admitted shortage of officer personnel and the present impossibility of increase, the matter of enlisted personnel becomes of more than usual importance. The necessity for competent clerks, interpreters, stenographers and typists in the Legal Section, which will be concerned with law office management and the administration of both military and civil courts is apparent, and enlisted personnel of suitable character will go far to overcome the insufficiency of officer personnel. With this in mind I am taking the liberty of suggesting procurement of certain personnel in accordance with my personal recommendations.

2. There is available at this Headquarters in the general pool of enlisted men, as yet unassigned, a group of men of Italian birth or extraction, which was attached to my contingent of graduates of the School of Military Government at Charlottesville for the journey from Washington to Algiers.
