Col. Balser (A) was sent to Tini Ouseu without any definite assignment. His name appears in pencil on a sheet in the possession of Col. Albright as Chief Counsel Region 7, and it has been suggested that he was unofficially offered in Washington the position of Chief Legal Officer Region 7.

In the opinion of the Assistant Chiefs of Staff this Officer is ~~not~~ not qualified to hold any position as Colonel in the Legal Division and no other appointment in that rank can be found for him. May we please be instructed as to the disposition of this Officer.

A/Lt.-Col. Hammer (B) was sent out to fill a position as Lt.-Col. Legal Division. This Officer's record in no way fits him to hold such a position, as after some years practice as a solicitor in a small way this Officer has acted since 1939 as manager of a law publishing firm. May it please be made clear to London that Officers with this type of record ought not to be sent out with Grade I rank for Legal Division. This Officer has been absorbed into establishment as SCAG.

Parkman and myself, I have to report that we consider that there is no suitable employment to be found for the aforementioned Officer in either AMG or A.C.A. He arrived from Washington and his experience has been mainly in manufacturing and education (administrative), with Military, executive and Staff experience since Dec. 1941. We do not consider, however, that the nature of this experience fits him for an appointment suitable to his age and rank. (He is 51).
