Dear Maxwell,

I am replying D.O. to your memoranda of the 13th and 14th September, regarding Lieutenants E.E.F. Benson and C.W.J. Newcombe, respectively, which have been passed to F.5. by the Civil Affairs Directorate in view of the fact that we have already had correspondence with Grafftey Smith, with whom we believed these two finance officers to be serving.

It is correct that these officers called on this branch just before going overseas and told us that various promises had been made to them. We told them that no promises with any authority could have been given to them, but that in the circumstances we would pass on what they had told us to the authorities on the spot. We accordingly, as stated above, wrote to Grafftey Smith from whom we gathered that he neither had any Captain's vacancies for these officers, nor naturally did he like the idea of promoting them rather than those who had already shown ability and had borne the heat and burden of the day.

We have not inconsiderable sympathy for these malcontents, as we suspect that lighthearted promises were in the past given without any authority or regard to the appointments likely to be available. We are, however, unable to produce chapter and verse. I can assure you that we have taken steps to see that no Civil Affairs officer now posted overseas is promised anything by anybody. He is told that he must first deliver the goods before he can be considered for promotion; moreover, promotion must even then depend upon vacancies.

The position of these Pay Corps Lieutenants is, of course, particularly difficult inasmuch as with their Corps Pay they are some few pence a day better off than as Staff Lieutenants. As regards the cases in question, I am afraid that there is nothing we can offer at this end, and can only leave it to you to promote them if they merit it, as and when opportunity arises.

In conclusion, may I express the hope that both of us have heard the last of this unfortunate kind of case.

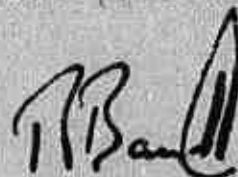

It would be appreciated if the question of my rank could be investigated. May the matter therefore be taken through the usual channels on my behalf.

The facts are as follows:-

In answer to an appeal made by the War Office for volunteers for service on Civil Affairs, my name was submitted in April of this year. I was then holding the rank of Captain, which rank I had held for two years and seven months, while holding the appointment of Staff Capt. at Worcester Sub-District.

Subsequently I was promoted to the rank of Major on taking up the appointment of DAQMG North Midland District, on 23 Jun 43. (Auth. MS 1/2/3454 dated 6 Jun. 43.) Immediately after taking up this appointment I was called to London for an interview by a Civil Affairs board. This was on the 16 Jun 43. The branch that instructed me to attend the interview addressed me as Captain, apparently unaware of my promotion. When I presented myself for the interview, I filled up the preliminary form showing my rank as Major.

At the interview I pointed to the board that I had been promoted to Major, and I was then given to understand that if selected for a Civil Affairs appointment I should not lose my rank as Major.

Next I was selected to attend a course of instruction at the Civil Affairs School at Wimbledon, commencing 29 Jul 43. At the end of the course the School received a letter from the War Office, indicating the names, ranks and grades to which they had been appointed. I was posted to a Grade 3 Appointment in the rank of Captain. I brought this to the notice of my Syndicate leader who took the matter up with the Commandant of the School, who decided that he could do nothing in the matter.

It was suggested that I took the matter up when I arrived at my destination. It would appear therefore that A.G.2(0) (Officer's Postings) were unaware of my promotion to Major, which was authorised by M.S. Branch under MS1/2/3454 dated 6 Jun 43.

Sir, on the advice of Lt.-Col. Aitken with whom I have discussed the matter briefly, I have the honour to place before you the following facts:

1. I was instructed to appear before an AMGOT Selection Board on 13th July at Flat 78, No 3 Whitehall Court. While awaiting my turn for interview, I was handed a typewritten memorandum to read which stated that selected candidates would attend a 5-weeks course at Wimbledon and that their ultimate rank would depend on the result of the course. At the subsequent interview, it appeared that the Board were not concerned with one's military rank or experience but solely with one's civilian qualifications.
2. On 29th July, I received posting instructions to report at the London District Assembly Centre on 7th August. In consequence of my not having attended a course, my rank remained unaltered.
3. Certain senior officers have informed me that all officers who attended a course at Wimbledon or at Peel House, in the case of the police, were given the rank of Captain and in some cases a higher rank, on the completion of the course.

- (a) I was admitted to the Institute of Chartered Accountants in January 1930.
- (b) From September 1930 until November 1938, I was on the staff of Price, Waterhouse & Co, London, where apart from normal audits and accountancy, I was also engaged on investigations.
- (c) In December 1938, I was appointed Assistant Secretary of North-Eastern Electric Supply Co. Ltd Newcastle-on-Tyne where my duties included the secretarship of the Contributory Superannuation Fund.
- (d) In April 1939, I was gazetted as 2nd Lieut. in one of the local territorial units, but in November of that year the War Office ordered me to return to my civilian employment and placed me on the Territorial Army Reserve of Officers. In January 1943 I was recalled and posted as a Lieut. to the unit in which I had been originally gazetted.
- (e) My firm's scheme of allowances to employees in H.M. Forces does not provide for ³⁹⁰⁸ grants to unmarried men. As my civilian salary in January 1943 was at the rate of £990. pa., you will appreciate that promotion is a matter of great importance to me. In addition, I feel, without undue conceit that my qualifications are at least equal to those of officers whose

rank is higher than mine.

There is also the possibility that Officers have not in all cases been assigned to suitable appointments - e.g. an officer assigned as C.A.O. in a Region might be more suitably placed in a post at E.C., A.C.A. or an officer assigned to the Staff of a Region may prove to be more suitable as a C.A.O.

3. Once a Region or A.C.A. is activated and assignments made, the normal system of Confidential reports (A.F. 2194D, E & F in the case of British, confidential letters in the case of American Officers) will operate, but it will then be much more difficult to make adjustments, as these will be dependent entirely upon vacancies.

Put in Subj. file

Will you therefore please consider carefully the questions raised in paras 2 and 3 above, both now, and as and when Officers are posted to you, and be prepared to submit recommendations for promotions, transfers, or transfers with promotion, at short notice. Lists and Records should be prepared now, and kept up to date.

5. Transfers within a Region (e.g. Adm Staff to C.A.O. or from one Special Division to another) may be made at any time without reference to ACA, but will be reported to A.C.A.(G-1) for record purposes. Transfers in all other cases require the sanction of A.C.A. in writing.

Sir,

I beg respectfully to bring to your notice the following details and to request your assistance in the matter.

At the interview by the War Office Selection Board I was informed that if finally selected for duties with C.T.A. I should be promoted to the next higher rank to that held. In this connection I explained that a Lieutenant and Paymaster R.A.F.C. I was already in receipt of paymasters rates, equivalent to Captains rates, and further that with 3½ years service, I was due for promotion to supervisory rank. I was therefore informed I should be given my majority.

In due course I was notified to proceed to the "Civil Affairs Centre", Wimbledon for a course of instruction on the 29th July 1943. This order was cancelled the day previous to joining the school and I was detailed to report to the London District Assembly Centre on the 7th August to proceed overseas.

On enquiring at C.A. 9, Hyde Park Gate regarding publication of promotion, ~~advised~~ the fact that promotion would not be granted until assignment. They contacted War Office F.5 and subsequently referred me to Mr. Round of that department.

I made personal representation to Mr. Round at F.5, who admitted it had not been realized that from the date of posting, viz. 7th August, 1943 I had to relinquish both pay and appointment of a Paymaster and revert to Regimental rates of Lieutenant on transfer to the General List.

Mr Round (F.5.) admitted a mistake had been made, as it was not the intention of the War Office that I should be penalized by a reduction in pay for volunteering for service with the Civil Affairs Administration (A.M.C.) but that it was too late to adjust on the day of departure. I was given a verbal assurance, however, that recommendation would be made to A.F. Headquarters, Algiers, by Airmail that promotion to the rank of Captain be made to cover the interim period between the date of transfer to the General List (7th Aug. 43) to the date of assignment. *3052*

Sir,

I was instructed by War Office (F.5) to make representations regarding my rank immediately on arrival in this country, they in turn, promised to write Headquarters Algiers on the subject.

I was informed at the interview by the Selection Board that if selected for duties with O.T.A., I should be granted promotion to the next highest rank. I explained that as a Lieut-Paymaster, I was already in receipt of pay equivalent to Captain's rates, and that with 3¹/₂ years service I was due for promotion to supervisory rank. This I was definitely told would be adjusted. On enquiring at C.A.9 I was told promotion would not be made until assignment was made. Up to that time it was not realised by the authorities in London that from the date of posting to the London District Assembly Centre on the 7th August I automatically relinquished my appointment and pay of a Paymaster on being posted to the General List.

This means a considerable financial loss from 7th August until such time as I am given my assignment.

On this being pointed out to War Office F.5 they admitted a mistake had been made, but stated it was too late for an adjustment to be made, but would write to Headquarters Algiers suggesting promotion to cover the period from the 7th August 1943 until the date of my final assignment.

May I request, therefore, this matter be taken up with Headquarters, Algiers, so that effect may be given to War Office recommendation.
