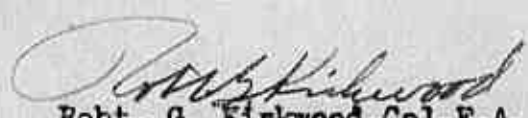

Your letter of 5 November has been received. We have requested by cable that Capt. L.W. Laughlin proceed to this station immediately by air. If this did not reach your station ask that he be sent immediately. We have also asked that Lt-Col. Laboon be sent here by air. If this has not been done please ask that he be ordered here.

Will you send immediately by air mail copies of the experience records of all men with Public Works or Utility experience as follows:

1. Now at your station.
2. Assigned to Region 9.
3. Assigned to Region 8.
4. Where experience records have been received and the men are, presumably, on the way to your station.

Below is a list of vacancies still existing in this Sub-Commission, and brief experience requirements. You are included in the assignments made here.

1. Deputy Chief Administration Branch. (Lt-Colonel) **4053**
Qualifications. Long experience in management and finance of Public Works and Utilities. It is essential that this man be of good personality, accustomed to committee and conference routine, administration and organisation ability of high order. It is essential that his experience be mainly on the management side.
2. Principal Assistant Administration Branch (Major).
Qualifications. Long experience in an executive capacity connected with large engineer-

ing organisations or public works and/or general utilities. Although it is desirable that this man shall have a good engineering background in all fields it is most essential that he has a very broad experience on the administrative side.

3. Public Works Branch (Captain or Lieutenant).

Qualifications. Experience in responsible position on public works projects. A good all round man is required accustomed to construction and maintenance of water undertakings, sewage disposal, reservoirs, irrigation and drainage schemes and it is also desirable that he have a working knowledge of gas undertakings.

4. Electrical Utilities Branch. (Major).

Qualifications. Experience in responsible position on Electric Power Station plant, sub-station equipment and overhead and underground distribution schemes. Design and operation experience is desirable.

5. Electrical Utilities Branch (Captain or Lieutenant).

Qualifications. Similar to those of Major but to a lesser degree.

particularly of higher ranks, should have long years and very broad specialized training in their respective fields. Engineers who do not meet this requirement, or who have only construction experience, must, of necessity, be assigned to regions.

I omitted the following from my form, as it was intimated to me by Sir John Patton, Fuel adviser to London HQ of C.D. that he wanted me to remain at Fuel.

In 1934, I was General Manager & Secretary to Central Iron & Coal Co. Ltd. & its subsidiaries & under the chairmanship of Sir Horace Losh - President of Board of Trade. I went to Scandinavia for the purpose of boosting British iron & steel as part of a commission. Incidentally the late Lord Rutherford was out at the same time and we had several conferences with Sir Hilditch the head of Bengel. He was also General Consul.

In 1926. I joined the Metallum AG of Berlin, which concern controlled a great number of continental industrial concerns, including Wollersdorfer Werke in Vienna (the Austrian Krupps) Eisenindustrie of Katowice etc. Owing to the war the market's all finance was controlled in London. Here I carried out purchases of British steel, iron, coal & semi products for shipment to the various works. Additionally the purchase of ores & semi's from our continental centre for consignment to another country were negotiated by notes in London by letter, cable & phone. In general I handled, ores, billets, blooms wire rods, non ferrous metals and did a big turnover in scrap. On one occasion I purchased two admiralty vessels, ⁴⁰⁰⁰ tons, then broken down at Boness in Scotland & shipped to Italy under the various types, nickel chrome steel etc. The finances of this undertaking were.

held in London in British & Foreign Bank
on the various currencies Lire, bolivar, Mexican
Guillem, etc, so necessitating a new
watch in the foreign exchange market.
The combine dissolved in 1929.

I joined Meniman & Co of Paris & London
as a Director. We were engaged in
Franco British trade, shipping coal etc
in to French & Lorraine steel works &
exporting steel products to England.
to such as Whitehead, etc etc

In 1937 I joined G. J. Goddard & Co. Ltd
to remain in England - see papers.

I have been T.A. since 1932 - returned
to active list 1938 - mobilised 1939. Served
as 2/c since 1941. Recommended to
War Office on two occasions by different CO's
in 1940.
