1. Reference your ACA/1048 dated 15th. Sep. 43 and our Suggested G1098 - Section LV7 - Trailers, Water, quantity 5 (five); *4691*

(a) As it is considered probable that on withdrawing from SARDINIA, the Germans will demolish to a large extent all public utilities, including potable water sources in the more populated areas.

(b) SARDINIA, especially those areas where it is proposed to set up Regional and Provincial Hqs, is malarial and consequently precautionary measures to prevent the contraction of this disease is essential.

(c) In the event of (a) above, potable water will have to be transported and temporarily stored where it cannot be contaminated and the watertanks are essential for this purpose.

It is therefore respectfully requested that this demand be approved.
