Sir,

- On Sunday, 10 October 1943, accompanied by Colonel Looms, Chief
 of Public Security Section, I inspected the latrines at Menerville
 Station.
- 2. The insanitary condition of the W.C. accomodation (Asiatic type) is beyond description! No water, foetid odours of nauseous vapour and pyramids of human excretion nearly two feet high.
- 3. FLY MENACE: faeces covered with flies like decaying meat in a Bagdad Suq.
- 4. Officers and OR's are frequently obliged to spend several hours at this station. (N.B. DRAFT RZKYF had an unusual proportion of TIZI OUZOU Belly).
- 5. Conclusion: The appalling state of the sanitation at the station in combination with the fly menace constitutes a grave danger to the health of troops in transit and to people laving in the locality.
- 6. Recommendation: It is my considered opinion that steps are necessary to inform the French Officials of Public Health in Algiers of this frightful, pre-historic lack of personal and public hygiene and I hereby beseech you to take all steps to have the matter rectified. Local labour for sanitary duties and to carry water can readily be obtained for a small financial outlay.
