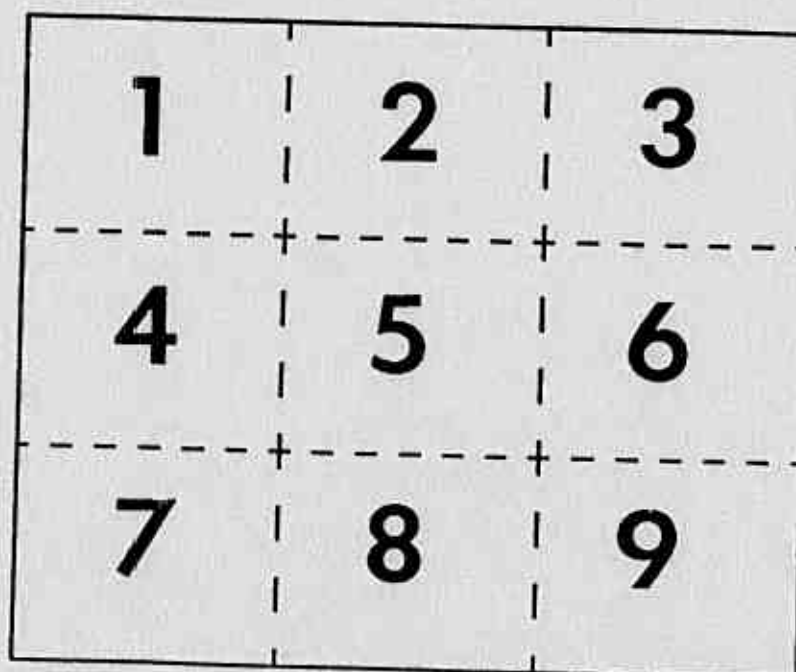
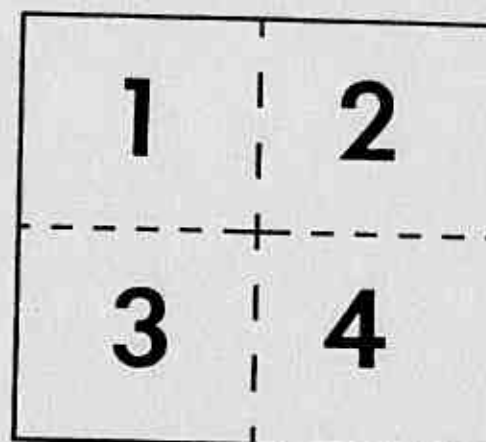
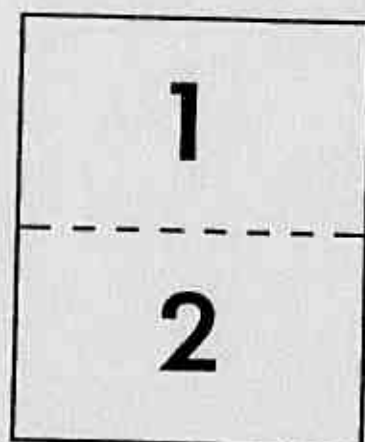

1. According to the latest returns the surplus and deficiencies of C.M. in A.M.G.A.C. are as shown on attached Appendix 'A'.

C.M. have noted the large surplus in C.D. personnel and have stated that owing to shortage of man power generally this surplus must be surrendered.

The surplus of Drivers i/c is being counted against the deficiency in motor cyclists, vehicle mechanics and driver mechanics - the result being a total deficiency of 115.

2. This matter has been fully discussed with C.D. and it has been arranged to return to I.A.T.D. a total of 119 C.D. men from Tizi Ouzou, made up as follows.

To be returned at once - 80
 To be lent to a Special Detachment, 19
 MGS on instructions from MGS.

(These men to be returned to I.T.D. on completion of duty).

To be returned to I.T.D. on completion of handing over of Tizi Ouzou after departure of the Tizi Ouzou party.

This will leave sufficient C.D. men for the Staff of the Holding Centre including the advanced party which has just been called forward.

3. There is still a surplus of some 180 C.D. men in A.C.C. and Regions. It is anticipated that owing to shortage in clerks and transport personnel some of these men will be either employed as such or suitable for training as such with a view to being mastered in these trades, e.g. there are now 10 C.D. men here being trained as clerks.

It is suggested that before the matter of returning the above surplus C.D. personnel to I.A.T.D., C.M. be approached, information be obtained from Regions etc., as to the number of C.D. men who could be trained as above.

C.M. have agreed to defer calling for the surrender of the remaining surplus of C.D. men in Italy until the above information has been obtained.

4. It should be noted that this large surplus has accrued through changes in establishment due to the ~~difference~~ in the new Global M.F.

5. There is still a surplus of some 180 G.D. men in H.Q. ACC, and Regions. It is anticipated that owing to shortage in clerks and transport personnel some of these men will be either employed as such or suitable for training as such with a view to being mustered in these trades, e.g. there are now 10 G.D. men here being trained as clerks.

It is suggested that before the matter of returning the above surplus G.D. personnel to I.B.A.D., C.M.F. be approached, information be obtained from Regions etc., as to the number of G.D. men who could be trained as above.

G.D. have agreed to defer calling for the surrender of the remaining surplus of G.D. men in Italy until the above information has been obtained.
