1. I cannot accept M. FARNY's contention that compensation should be paid to him on the basis of what he might have made if he had been free to let the rooms on "en pension" terms. I understand the remainder of this hotel is requisitioned by the French and undoubtedly they are paying him on the basis of the "prix-homologué" less a percentage as laid down by the "arreté" of the Government-General of 6 May 43.

2. In point of fact, as this occupation is considered an American responsibility under the arrangements that have been made for the payment of accommodation occupied by the Military Government School the matter will have to be finalised by the Intendance, and if you can obtain the "prix homologué" rates for rooms 2 and 8 I will send them the necessary information to enable them to do so.

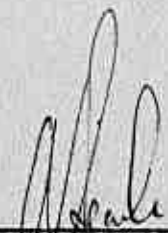

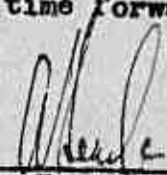

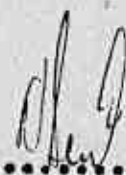

Attached is a statement of accommodation as of to-day 21 Dec 43. It will be seen that of the vacant beds 47 are under cover. If 60 officers leave it may be assumed that approximately 40 beds under cover would be vacated, giving a total of 87 beds. On the same assumption, 20 of those leaving would have been sleeping in tents, leaving 48 still under canvas. It would, therefore, be impossible to move all officers on the post into covered accommodation.

The war establishment (British) does not provide for cooking personnel except for one small overflow mess. This American company is accustomed to cooking on American petrol cookers, and not on 72" ranges which they accordingly removed.

It is regretted that R.E. material and labour has been wasted, but the removal of the ranges was made without any reference to the British section. It is pointed out that the petrol used in the American cookers is drawn from American sources.

It is also pointed out that only the 72" ranges in the men's cookhouse have been removed. The one being installed in "B" Mess will be fully used, and will be worked by British cooks.

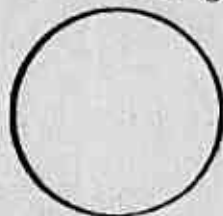
