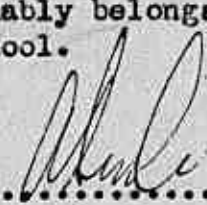

- (1) A form (P/A/8) will be filled in in duplicate for each prospective employee.
- (2) The space below this line in the middle of the form will be left blank.
- (3) Both copies of the form will be sent to the Port or Field Security Section which normally vets civilian employees for the H.Q. or unit. (See 7 below).
- (4) On completion of vetting one copy of the form will be returned to the H.Q. or unit by the Security Section with the result of the vetting filled in.
- (5) In refusing any civilian employment as a result of one of these vettings, NO reason will be given and NO mention of the Security Officer or Section will be made.
- (6) Stocks of these forms will be distributed by the relevant Security Sections to Formations and units. Units which have not received FORMS P/A/8 can obtain them by application to the relevant Security Section. (See 7 below).
