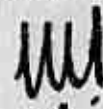

APPARATUS, DECONTAMINATING, 1 - 1/2 QUART

1. General. Each commanding officer is responsible that all fuel consuming motor vehicles, except motorcycles, in his unit are equipped with apparatus, decontaminating, 1-1/2 quart and that each apparatus is filled and kept ready for use. This also applies to other items of equipment for which the apparatus is authorized.

2. Supply.

a. Initially, the complete apparatus with bracket, four extra bolts and filling funnel will be requisitioned directly from CWS Depots by the Ordnance unit charged with installing it.

b. Replacements will be requisitioned by the unit through normal channels from CWS Depots.

3. Installation.

a. Ordnance units will install the mounting bracket and empty apparatus at the time of initial assembly or servicing of the newly received vehicle, and will, on requisition, make the same installations on unequipped vehicles in storage and in the hands of troops. The filling funnel will become an item of equipment in the tool box of each vehicle.

b. After this initial installation, the apparatus becomes an accessory of the vehicle and Ordnance responsibility ceases except for apparatus installed on vehicles in possession of Ordnance units.

4. Location.

a. Locations for the installation of the apparatus will be as listed below. (Brackets already installed need not be relocated.)

Truck, 1/4 Ton, 4x4: Immediately to rear of right front seat horizontally mounted against body ledge located as close to center of vehicle as bulge in ledge will permit.

Truck, 3/4 Ton, 4x4, Weapons Carrier: Front, left body projection.

Truck, 3/4 Ton, 4x4, Command: Inside top, rear trunk compartment.

Truck, 3/4 Ton, 4x4, Carryall: Inside between rear windows.

Truck, 3/4 Ton, 4x4, Ambulance: Left hand inside panel recess (same as fire extinguisher but on opposite side).

Truck, 1-1/2 Ton, 4x4: Behind seat cushion. On panel model, between seats.

Truck, 2 1/2 Ton, 6x6, LWB and SWB, Cargo: Behind seat cushion.

Truck, 2 1/2 Ton, 6x6, 750-gallon Gasoline Tanker: Behind seat cushion.

Truck, 4-5 Ton, and 5-6 Ton, 4x4: Federal model 4-5 Ton, 4x4, right rear corner of cab. Autocar 4-5 Ton and 5-6 Ton model, between driver's seat and side of body.

Carriage, Motor, 3" Gun, M10: Under door of right rear box in crew compartment (same location as fire extinguisher).
Carriage, Motor, 105mm Howitzer, M7: On inside left trail of gun mount.
Carriage, Motor, 37mm Gun, M6: Under dash, left front.

b. For any types of vehicles not covered by the above tabulation which may be received in the theater without the apparatus, the latter will be installed in a location selected by the Ordnance unit assembling or preparing the vehicle for service. In such instances the directions for location given in paragraph 4a will be used as a guide, and the apparatus will be installed in a covered and protected but easily accessible location.

5. Filling and Maintenance.

a. References.

Procedure for filling and maintenance of the apparatus is described in detail in TM 3-220 dated 7 March 1943 and Change Number 1 to TM 3-220, dated 7 September 1943. The following important steps in this procedure are outlined for careful study and compliance by all concerned.

b. Filling and Care.

This apparatus will be filled with decontaminating agent non-corrosive (DANG), with date of filling affixed to each apparatus. Solution should be changed every three months. The shut-off valve, filling plug and spray nozzle will be kept well covered with moderately heavy grease, in order to prevent corrosion when the apparatus is not in use. The handle will be kept down and turned so as to lock the shut-off valve.

c. Weekly Inspection.

Remove each filled apparatus from its bracket and operate the pump to determine if it is functioning properly. Ejection and loss of liquid will be kept to a minimum. If the apparatus functions properly, wipe the nozzle dry with a rag and re-apply grease. If the apparatus does not function, it should be cleaned and repaired.

d. Monthly Maintenance will be accomplished by draining and overhauling the apparatus, as described in change Number 1 to TM 3-220, dated 7 September 1943.

e. Responsibility.

The supervision of weekly inspections and monthly maintenance is a responsibility of the unit gas officer, who also is charged with the keeping of filling, inspection and maintenance records.
