I hereby certify that I was present at the hearing of Harchaoui, Mohammed Ben Hacene, and that the attached translation which follows is true and correct the best of my ability to translate.

In before us, Moreno, Jean, Commissaire of the Mobile Police at Tizi Ouzou, office of the Judicial Police, auxiliary of N. The prosecutor of the Republic:

Presents the one named Harchaoui, Mohamed ben Gacene, aged 14, employed at the W/O & Sgts Mess, British, at Tizi Ouzou, who tells us the following:

I have been employed by the W/O's & Sgts, British, for five months.

Approximately ten days ago, at or about 2100 hours while serving at the British W/O's & Sgts Mess, I saw a soldier, whom I know is called Foster, Robert, nicknamed Bob, enter into the W.C. of the apartment of Mrs Boyer, located across from the Salle des Fêtes of Tizi Ouzou. Inside of the W.C. is a closed door that goes into the dining room of Mrs Boyer's apartment. I saw this soldier open this door, but I cannot tell you how he did it. He came out several instants later carrying in his hands a pair of mens boots. This soldier did not speak to me. As for me, I said nothing to him. I finished my work a few instants later and went to the movies. Then I returned from the movies together with two British soldiers named Paddy and Jimmy, I saw Foster, Robert, nicknamed Bob together with the woman named Chabha, who is a servant employed by Mrs Gouin, at Tizi Ouzou. I saw them later enter into the apartment of Mrs Boyer, entering via the W.C. they did not come out again until the following morning at 0600 hours, more or less.

That afternoon, towards 1500 or 1600 hours I saw Foster come out again from the apartment of Mrs Boyer. He told me in confidence that he had withdrawn from this apartment a silver coin of 20 francs as well as several other pieces of 10 francs and 5 francs. At the time that he was confiding this to me, the one named Paddy was by my side. He took out 2 pieces of 5 francs from his pocket of his coat and gave them to me saying "Keep this, its a souvenier".

The following day during the day I encountered Miss Micheline Chateau Reynaud in the court yard of the Mess. I showed her the two 5 francs pieces saying to her that they had absolutely no value since they were now out of circulation. She asked me to be good enough to make her a present of them saying to me that with the metal she would have a ring made. I gave them to her. This same day I saw Foster, Robert, nicknamed Bob having in his possession a white bath towel that came from the apartment of Mrs. Boyer.

Yesterday afternoon, Foster, Robert, having learned of the return of Mrs Boyer, asked me to give him back the two 5 franc pieces. I went to ask Miss Micheline for them and she gave them back to me. I gave them back to him and he put them, in my presence, in his purse.

I have nothing more to tell you and I affirm having told you the whole truth in this matter.
