This memorandum is to confirm our cable CA/235 of this date which states in effect:

The Navy will be in urgent need of local native pilots in HORRIFIED ports and wishes to obtain their services at the earliest practicable moment. C.A.Os should be instructed not to intern or imprison any such native personnel without consultation with Naval Authorities, and should make every effort to locate them, obtain their services, and after investigation into their loyalty and qualifications, turn them over to the local Naval Authority.

HUSKY - ITALIAN PILOTS IN CAPTURED PORTS

The services of local pilots are of extreme importance to the efficient working of captured ports and it is therefore requested that early steps be taken to ensure that these pilots are made available to the port authorities as soon as possible. On previous occasions considerable delay has sometimes been caused by the pilots being interned or imprisoned by the military authorities immediately on occupation.
