1. Owing to transport difficulties it is not possible to meet individual officers arriving in Algiers by air for Civil Affairs. They should be instructed to take their own way by the hourly bus service, or other available transport, from the aerodrome to Allied Force H.Q. From there, they should get into touch by telephone with an officer of this branch at 14th Force H.Q., who will arrange for their onward movement.
2. Officers should bring as much of their kit and bedding as possible. Blankets (but not sheets) are available here, but soap and other toilet requisites, towels, knives, forks, spoons, mugs, are in very short supply.

1. Lord Russell left for London on 1st May, and expects to be away a week or ten days. As I instructed me to open all his correspondence, I opened your 14634/47 of 30th April, and send you this short interim reply. He asked me to thank you for your very great assistance regarding staff. I attach a list of the staff you are supplying, for record purposes. Things have been much more satisfactory here, lately, and the future seems clearer. We are desperately busy planning, and trying to fix up a school and accommodation for the three to four hundred officers who are shortly coming from the U.S. and U.K. Accommodation is desperately short, and only a skeleton staff of some dozen officers and clerks will remain here. We have asked you to hold the N. and S. African candidates in Cairo for the time being, as we have nowhere to put them. It is hoped that the school and accommodation will be available towards the end of this month, and we will then endeavour to get them brought forward. It is very interesting working in with the Americans on a fifty-fifty basis, and it is going extremely well to date. Thank you for only selecting good staff for us from Britain, as we shall have several hundred completely untrained officers to deal with, this is essential.

2. Your para. 2, if Capt. Samitt-aines is available and you consider him good, we would like him, provided he can really talk Italian.

3. The question whether the C.A. is to be British or American is still under consideration. Lord Russell may have the answer on his return from London. If British, it will probably be Crafter-Smith. In any case, he is required for planning.

4. If O'Zacks can get up here to lecture and advise, his help will be invaluable. We telegraphed about this. We have no one with any knowledge of D.F. Police organisation.

5. If Hyatt is not available at present, that is that and we must try elsewhere.

6. We heard Willan was not available for us. I hope you got him.

7. Thank you for your assistance to 345 Force. We are producing various instructional documents which will be sent to them in due course.

AND PERSONALMy dear *Francis*

Your letter of the 21st of April was received by the hand of Taffy on the 27th. I do not know whether there is another letter from you on the way but I had expected to hear from you regarding the list of officers which I sent to you by the hand of Richard. I need hardly say that the Chief Administrator in Eritrea offered other candidates whom I did not consider you would welcome, though they might do for odd jobs. They are Captain Ronayne, Captain Peacocke and Lt. Smyth-Osborne. You can, of course, have any of these if you want them, but I did not mention them in the list I gave to Richard so as to assure you of my good faith in the release of bodies.

2. We have also learned that there is a Captain Zammit-Haines now serving with G.S.I. (Censorship) who might be releasable to us. He is said to have perfect Italian but I do not know any more about him than that.

3. I am already committed to the release of Jameson to Nairobi and a telegram has just come in confirming his appointment there though I cannot send him until the end of May as Stephen has just gone on leave. The latter is not too fit and is having serious trouble with his eye-sight, so with the bodies that I am giving you, Eritrea is likely to be in a bad way again. Here we are extremely busy and I did not bring up Gibbons to act in Bill's place since I knew that Stephen was going on leave and I had also taken young Laird from the Secretariat. They will have to take Kirkwood from the Secretariat to replace Gerald Wellesley and I shall therefore have to send Bill Arundell to Eritrea as C.S. until I can get Eritrea staff on its feet again. Meanwhile we are trying to recruit 75 students for the A.T.B. Civil Affairs School which is commencing on the 15th of May.

4. Mike is now immersed in the financial and supply planning for the Balkans and is quite unable to go to Nairobi where undoubtedly Somalia requires his attention. I do not see how we can continue the joint appointment of the C.F.A. for the two Commands with the prospects ahead of us in the Balkans.

6. I gather from Taffy that you are pretty browned off and I am not surprised from what he told me. Have you any further news from the War Office about the establishment of the new Directorate. The latest I have is a reference to the decision in the A.T.(2) Minutes of the 2nd of April., where they go on to say that there is a hitch in implementing the decision.

7. I forget to say that the immediate release of Myatt is quite impossible; our supply situation is most unsatisfactory and Mike has found it necessary to put Merrill in charge of the Supply Department in Eritrea which he found in a pretty good mess, thanks to the activities of Master Watson.

8. I hear from Bill that the War Office have agreed to release Willan as Chairman of the Maize Control Enquiry "without prejudice to decision of any later request they may make for his release for further military employment". A few days ago I had a long telegram from the War Office setting out their proposals for my planning staff for Malaya. They did not propose anyone with experience of C.E.T.A. except Sanders, Director of Transport in Eritrea, so I proposed that I should be given a Supply officer from Mideast and also a Legal Adviser with C.E.T.A. experience. I suggested that Willan should be selected as he was fully qualified to become Attorney General Malaya in the Civil Government - a post which is better than A.G. Kenya and should attract him. To this there is no reply so far and I doubt if I shall get him. There is no further news about my successor and I am getting deeper and deeper into Balkan affairs which seems a pity.

9. I am giving 645 Force help when they require it but on the whole I do not think there is anything which is so urgent that cannot wait your arrival here. I have given them 25 copies of Part I of the Handbook (revised edition) which apparently most of them had not seen before.

10. I do hope I see you soon, but I shall certainly have to go to Tripoli in the course of the next week and I trust we shall not miss each other. Mike, in any case, will have to be here whilst I am away.
