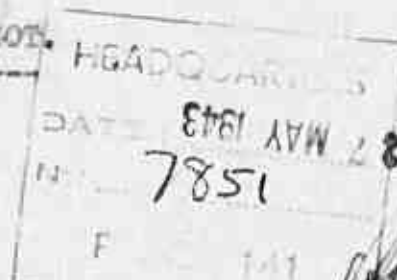

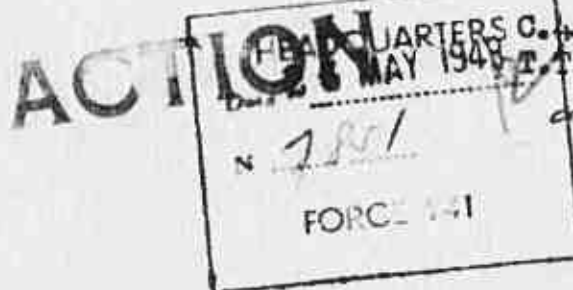

Dear Lord Rennell,

I arrived in Cairo at the end of March after a rather tiresome sea passage from Mombasa.

2. A provisional arrangement to go to Tripoli made with Brig. Lush when I reported at H.Q. for duty, had to be abandoned for the following reason.

3. Owing to inadequate treatment for dysentery during the last fortnight of our stay in Madagascar, due to shortage of the necessary medicaments, I was advised to have hospital tests made in Cairo. As they proved positive, although latent, I took the course of routine treatment, in two periods of 12 days with an interval of a fortnight between, which concluded last Tuesday with an entirely satisfactory outcome.

4. During the fortnight's interval, it was intimated at this H.Q. that, most probably, I should join you as soon as I was free to make the journey but, on reporting for duty yesterday I learned that another three or more weeks may elapse before other officers are required in Algiers.

5. To one who is eager to be at work this is rather a dismal prospect and I should be most grateful if my transfer could be effected forthwith as I am sure that I should be better occupied in preliminary planning under your direction for future possibilities than marking time here.

6. This opinion is shared by Lt. Col. Smith-Dorrien who hesitates to enrol me in his A.T.(P) scheme under the impression that I shall ultimately be required in your organization.

7. This letter is prompted, as I feel sure you will understand, by eagerness to make a creditable contribution in a sphere which is most suited to my experience and qualifications and if an early advice can be sent that I may join you at once, I shall greatly appreciate it.
