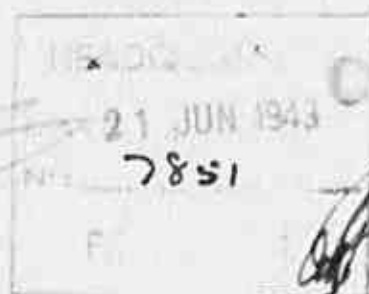

Dear Francis.

Brigadier Wheeler, XO Commanding 12 AA Bde 12 Army has been to see me about the preservation of the monuments in HORRIFIED. He fully recognizes that he has no official right to butt in on the question, but he is one of the leading British Archaeologists and carried out the excavations at Maiden Castle, Dorset, which created so much interest just before the outbreak of war. During the Tripoli Campaign he did what he could for the preservation of the monuments in an unofficial capacity and got Major J. B. Ward Perkins attached to the staff of Brig. Lush as adviser on antiquities. In civilian life Major Ward Perkins is Professor of Archaeology at the University of Valetta and he knows the antiquities of HORRIFIED thoroughly. Professor (Temp. Brig.) Wheeler says that Perkins could now be spared in Tripoli and has suggested that his appointment in a similar capacity in HORRIFIED might be considered. The suggestion seems to me a good one and I am therefore forwarding it to you in a personal letter for any action which you may think fit to take on it.

Wheeler is trying to see Billy Harleah who is here today and leaving for London tomorrow to see if he can get some Baedekers of S. Italy which will be of great value as compendiums of the antiquities. He is fully alive to the security difficulties which surround getting guidebooks but these are less formidable in London than here.

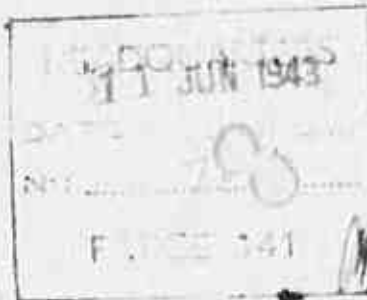

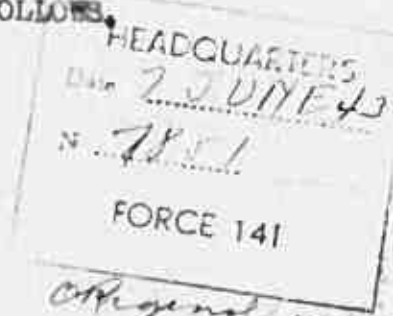

1. Reference your Draft Memo to C.C.A.O. dated 30 May 43.

2. In order to obtain the information upon which to draft a new W.S. based as suggested in your memo, the following particulars are required in respect of the H.Q. Staff and each Division:

A. OFFICERS

The number of British officers, detailed by ranks as:
2 Colonels, 5 Lt. Colonels, etc. In making out these totals an additional reserve percentage to cover extra commitments or unforeseen difficulties should be allowed for over and above the numbers set out in Appendices to the new plan. (10% has been suggested).

B. CLERKS

The number of British clerks, detailed by ranks as:
1 W.O.I., 3 W.O.II, 5 S/Sgts., etc. The following considerations must be borne in mind when calculating requirements:

(i) A large number of AMGOT officers will not have any static office.

(ii) Of those officers who will work in offices:

(a) Some will be attached to other formations and will be able to make use of such formations' clerical staff.

(b) Others, either because they are moving about or have no transport for carrying clerks about will have to use local labour.

(iii) A reasonable scale of clerks for officers not coming within head (i) or head (ii) a & b is 3 clerks to every 2 officers, to include the extra percentage referred to in 2(a) above.

C. TRANSPORT

Reference your minute 3 June, the answers to the points raised are as follows.

A. Officers

You should circulate C.S.O. and Heads of Divisions asking them to return to you the total number of British officers with rank. You will not mention the 10% extra which will be added subsequently by you after consultation with Col. Spofford and myself.

B. Clerks

You will not ask the C.S.O. and Divisions for these figures in the first instance but work on the establishment as at 30 April, increased pro rata to the increase between the 30 April establishment and the Annexes to the final plan. As a guide the same percentage of clerks to officers on as 30 April will be followed, which calculation will be made after excluding the C.A.F.Os in both cases.

C. Battalion

You should discuss this matter with the C.S.O. and your joint recommendations on the alterations should be submitted also.

D. Transport

The following principles will apply:

- (i) C.A.P.Os are not entitled to motor vehicles except of the rank of Major and above. M/Cs may be allocated on the basis of 55% of C.A.P.Os. A suitable increase in the number of driver-mechanics should be incorporated.

- (iv) You should be careful in assessing the increase in transport to make sure that British transport and American transport will be neither more nor less than is required in connection with the global T/O R.E. in accordance with the Appendices as for 4731, officers are concerned and as adjusted by you for C.Rs British, and estimated by you as to R.M. American

E. G.1098

As a parallel operation you should keep Major Pearey closely informed so that he can immediately put in hand an increased application for the new establishment from Ordnance for the appropriate G.1098.

No clerks, drivers or vehicles will be included in respect of the 10 additional officers, since as and when they are posted, considerable progress should have been made towards incorporating native drivers, clerks and transport into A.G.O.F organization.

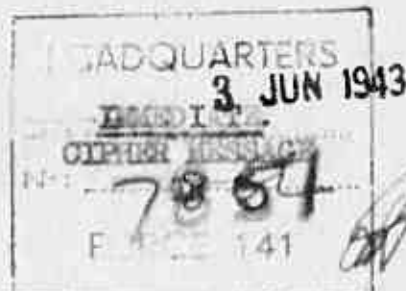

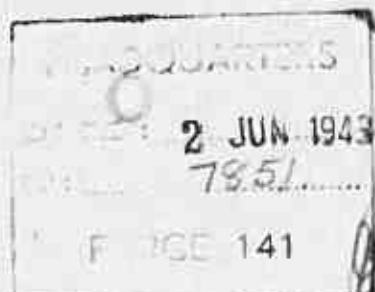

My dear Rennell,

I have just seen W.J. Keswick (known to his friends as Tony) and have asked him whether he would be prepared to take a job under you for the forthcoming operation. I told him that the rank which he would hold in the first instance at any rate would be that of Captain, and I also told him that the question whether he would get responsibilities justifying a higher rank would be up to him and subject to your opinion of him.

Charles Hambro has a high opinion of him which I am inclined to share after seeing him. He tells me that he was Managing Director of Jardine Mathieson, and lived for 15 years in Shanghai and Hong Kong. He was for a time Chairman of the Shanghai Municipal Council. He is 38 years of age. He was Controller of Missions at S.O.S. He went with Duff Cooper on his tour of the world.

His main difficulty is that for one reason or another he would like to go into the ranks of the Army and qualify for a commission if he could. The idea of being an imitation officer does not appeal to him very strongly, particularly as his position in the S.O.S. outfit gave him equivalent rank of something like Colonel or Brigadier.

Would you very kindly let me know at once, either by cable or by returning individual, whether you would like to have him and, if so, what class of responsibility you would propose to give him and what rank. My own view is that it would be a great pity to lose his services. He is obviously a man of considerable commercial experience, has a very attractive personality, and could hold his own well in conference even with Americans present.

I may have made him out to be rather conceited as regards rank, but I don't think that is being fair to him. His point is that he doesn't mind being a private soldier and climbing up to be a 2nd Lieutenant. He is

a genuine 2nd Lieutenant, but if he is going to be made into what he calls a phoney officer he rather feels, I suspect, that his capacity merits higher rank than Captain.

We have had a fair passage of arms with the Joint Staff Mission on the question of your financial control, and you will be receiving a copy of their telegram and of the raspberry which we sent in reply.

I have great hopes of meeting you in Washington.
