TO: C.S.O. - To discuss with Brig Woods.

Attached is list of deficiencies, which must be formed by O.2.E as per para 2 formation letter (G-1(B) 1003/94/A.1. dated 26 May 43. These may be replaced later from U.K. (see copy Troopers 81192 MDII of 19 May 43 attached). An urgent wire has been sent to Troopers but no reply has yet been received. Time is getting very short and the following are urgently required:-

1. Transport Personnel (Drivers, Drivers mechanics, and D.R.)
Transport is expected to be available for drawing in about a week's time and we have no drivers (see Major Pearce's letter)
2. Clerks
Clerks are urgently required for Detachment Force 545. A dozen qualified clerks are wanted at once for this purpose. In any event all deficiencies must be made up by the end of the month.
3. Batmen and General Dutymen
We are over establishment here but a new S.A. is being prepared which contains an appropriate scale.

At the moment we have attached a large number of "bomb-happy" personnel. As we may have to send batmen away with officers, these personnel should be replaced as soon as possible, as they cannot stand bombing etc.
